

## Deed No. 2666

RESOLUTION NO. 6539

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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING A PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT OVER A PORTION OF LOT 1, CALIFORNIA GROVES.

WHEREAS, on the 14th day of December, 1954, Ordinance No. 2151 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the intention of the City Council to vacate a public utility easement over a portion of Lot 1, California Groves, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Service Easements Vacation Law; and,

WHEREAS, in said ordinance the time of hearing was set for Thursday, February 9, 1955, at 10:00 o'clock A. M. in the Council Chamber located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets, Riverside, California, at which said time and place all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation be allowed to be heard; and,

WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Section 50441 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, a hearing of the ordinance of intention was had before said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at which time the evidence offered by persons interested was heard by the legislative body; and the legislative body found from all of the evidence submitted that the public utility easement which the legislative body declared its intention to vacate is unnecessary for present or prospective public use.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the public utility easement over a portion of Lot 1, California Groves, in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

The northerly ten feet (10') of the easterly sixty and eighty-five hundredths feet (60.85') of Lot 1, California Groves, as shown on a map recorded in Map Book 25 at page 37, Records of Riverside County;


1 is unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and that  
2 the same be and is hereby vacated.

3 It is further ORDERED that the Clerk cause a certified copy  
4 of this order, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the  
5 Office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.
