Thence South 61° 00' 30" East, a distance of 25 feet to the point of beginning of the parcel to be described;
Thence North 29° 00' East and parallel with the northwesterly line of said Lot 89, a distance of 75 feet;
Thence South 61° 00' 30" East, and parallel with the southwesterly line of said Lot 89, a distance of 8 feet;
Thence South 29° 00' West and parallel with the northwesterly line of said Lot 89, a distance of 56 feet;
Thence South 61° 00' 30" East and parallel with the southwesterly line of said Lot 89, a distance of 86 feet;
Thence South 29° 00' West and parallel with the northwesterly line of said Lot 89, a distance of 19 feet;
