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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, NAMING URBAN STREET.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, pursuant to recommendation of the Planning Commission of said City, that the parcel of land hereinafter described be, and the same is hereby named URBAN STREET.

The said street extends north from Arlington Avenue and is east of Hall Street, and is the parcel of land in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, particularly described as follows:

Lot A, Galford Gardens, as shown by map on file in Book 12, page 97 of Maps, Records of Riverside County, California; also the easterly 8 feet of lots 50 to 55, inclusive, and the easterly 8 feet of Lot 59 of said Galford Gardens.
