RESOLUTION NO. 7759

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2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND
4 DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF ORDINANCE OF
5 INTENTION NO. 2501; RESERVING TO THE CITY EASE-
6 MENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY, AND DETERMINING THAT
7 THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRES
8 RESERVATION OF SUCH EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY;
9 AND ORDER OF VACATION IN THE MATTER OF VACATING
10 A PEDESTRIAN WAY.

11 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riverside, Cali-
12 fornia, adopted an ordinance of intention, No. 2501, pursuant
13 to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being
14 Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State
15 of California, declaring its intention to vacate a certain pe-
16 destrian way or walkway therein and hereinafter described; and,

17 WHEREAS, the matter came on regularly for hearing before said
18 City Council at the time and place fixed for hearing by said
19 ordinance of intention, and said City Council heard and considered
20 all of the evidence submitted.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by said City Council that it
22 be and is hereby found and determined by said City Council that
23 said ordinance of intention was duly passed, adopted and published
24 in the manner prescribed by law for the adopting and publishing of
25 ordinances of said City, and the notice of said vacation proceed-
26 ings and of the time and place of hearing was given by posting,
27 as provided by the Street Vacation Act of 1941, and that the said
28 pedestrian way or walkway therein described is unnecessary for
29 present or prospective public purposes and should be vacated.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of the said Street
31 Vacation Act of 1941, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the City Council of
32 the City of Riverside, California, that the pedestrian way or walk-
way in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of Cali-
fornia, described as follows, to wit:

A Pedestrian Walkway shown as Lot "D" on map of

1 California Square on file in Book 25, pages 27
2 and 38 of Maps, Records of Riverside County,
California;

3 EXCEPTING THEREFROM AND RESERVING for use
4 as a Public Utility Easement, the Southwesterly
5 10 feet of said Lot "C";

6 be, and the same is hereby, vacated.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby
8 determine that the public convenience and necessity require the
9 reservation of permanent easements and rights of way to construct,
10 maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge conduits,
11 cables, wires, poles and other convenient structures, equipment
12 and fixtures for the operation of telegraphic and telephone lines,
13 and for the transportation and distribution of electric energy,
14 and incidental purposes, including access, and the right to keep
15 the property free from inflammable materials, and wood growth,
16 and otherwise protect the same from all hazards in, upon and
17 over the pedestrian way or walkway proposed to be vacated, and
18 to take proceedings for the abandonment of the said pedestrian
19 way or walkway as hereinabove set forth, subject to such reserva-
20 tions and exceptions.

21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City of
22 Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested
23 by the City Clerk under the seal of said City, to be recorded
24 in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County,
25 California.
