A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING A RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT FOR STORM DRAIN PURPOSES.

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WHEREAS, on August 19, 1958, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted a Resolution No. 8323, declaring its intention to order the vacation of a right of way easement for storm drain purposes therein described, and fixing the time and place for hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Service Easements Vacation Law, being Sections 50430 et seq., of the Government Code; and,

WHEREAS, said proposed vacation was submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by said Public Service Easements Vacation Law; and,

WHEREAS, on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested, and found, and hereby finds, from all of the evidence submitted that the right of way easement for storm drain purposes herein-after ordered vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that a right of way easement for storm drain purposes in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

That certain strip of land, 20 feet in width, lying 10 feet northwesterly and 10 feet southeasterly of the southeasterly line of the northwesterly half of Lot 5, Block 8 of the Lands of the Riverside Land and Irrigating Company, as shown by map on file in Book 1, page 70 of Maps, Records of San Bernardino County, California.

EXCEPTING that portion of said 20 foot strip lying within that certain drainage easement as conveyed to the City of Riverside by deed recorded January 20, 1956, in Book 1850 at page 321, Official Records of Riverside County, California.

RESERVING also for use as a right of way and easement


1 for the construction, maintenance, operation, inspection,
2 repair, replacement and removal of guys, anchors, fixtures
3 and appurtenances, for the transmission of electric energy
4 for any and all purposes for which the same may be used,
5 upon, over and across the following described portion of
6 said 20 foot strip:

7 Beginning at the intersection of the southeasterly
8 line of said 20-foot strip and the southwesterly line of the
9 said drainage easement conveyed to the City of Riverside;
10 thence southwesterly along the southeasterly line of said
11 20-foot strip a distance of 35 feet; thence at a right angle
12 northwesterly, a distance of 5 feet; thence at a right angle
13 northeasterly to an intersection with the southwesterly line
14 of the said drainage easement conveyed to the City of
15 Riverside; thence southeasterly along said southwesterly
16 line to the point of beginning;

17 is unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and that
18 the same be and is hereby vacated.

19 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City of
20 Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested
21 by the City Clerk under the seal of said City, to be recorded in
22 the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.
