2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND
4 DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF
5 INTENTION NO. 8405; RESERVING EASEMENTS AND
6 RIGHTS OF WAY PROVIDED IN SECTION 8330 OF THE
7 STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE, AND DETERMINING
8 THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE
9 RESERVATION OF SUCH EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY
10 AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 8331 OF SAID CODE; AND
11 ORDER OF VACATION IN THE MATTER OF VACATING
12 PORTIONS OF STREETS.

14 WHEREAS, on November 5, 1958, the City Council of the
15 City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 8405 declaring its
16 intention to order the vacation of portions of streets, and
17 fixing the time and place for hearing all persons interested
18 in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the
19 Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Sections 8300 et seq. of
20 Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the
21 State of California; and,

22 WHEREAS, said proposed vacation was submitted to and
23 acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside,
24 and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by
25 said Street Vacation Act of 1941; and,

26 WHEREAS, on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council
27 heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested,
28 and found, and hereby finds, from all of the evidence submitted
29 that the said portions of streets hereinafter ordered vacated
30 are unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

31 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City
32 Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the portions
of streets in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of
California, and described as follows:

Those portions of Fifth Street, 66 feet in width;
Sixth Street, 66 feet in width; and Mulberry
Street, 66 feet in width, in the Town of Riverside,
as shown by map on file in Book 7, at page 17,
records of San Bernardino County, California, des-
cribed as follows:

1 That portion of Fifth Street lying between
2 the northwesterly right of way line of the State
3 Freeway, VIII - RIV. - 43 - RIV, and the south-
easterly line of Mulberry Street; and

4 That portion of Sixth Street lying between
5 the northwesterly right of way line of the State
6 Freeway, VIII - RIV. - 43 - RIV, and a line drawn
parallel with, and a perpendicular distance of
112.00 feet northwesterly from the northwesterly
line of Mulberry Street; and,

7 That portion of Mulberry Street lying between
8 the northwesterly right of way line of the State
9 Freeway, VIII - RIV. - 43 - RIV, and the southwest-
erly line of Fifth Street.

10 EXCEPTING AND RESERVING permanent easements
11 and rights of way as hereinafter mentioned,

12 are unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and that
13 the same be and are hereby vacated.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby
15 determine that the public convenience and necessity require the
16 reservation of permanent easements and rights of way to construct,
17 maintain, operate, replace, remove and renew sanitary sewers,
18 and storm drains and appurtenant structures in, upon, over and
19 across the portions of said streets vacated, and reserving the
20 right to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew
21 and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles and
22 other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures for the
23 operation of gas pipe lines, telegraphic and telephone lines,
24 and for the transportation and distribution of electric energy,
25 petroleum and its products, water, and incidental purposes, in-
26 cluding access, and the right to keep the property free from
27 inflammable materials, and weed growth, and otherwise protect
28 the same from all hazards in, upon and over the portions of said
29 streets vacated.

30 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City of
31 Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested
32 by the City Clerk under the seal of said City, to be recorded in
the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.

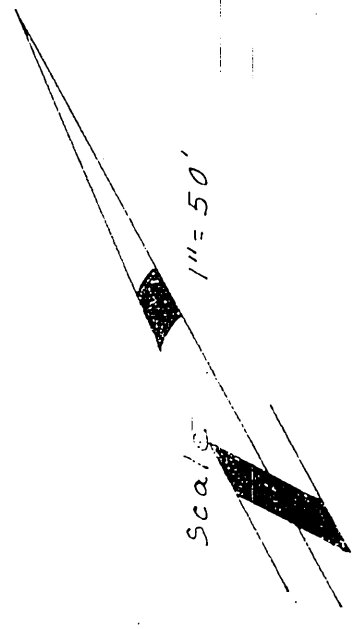
