

RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE ACCEPT-
ING DEEDS.

RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, that those certain deeds to the City of Riverside, aforesaid County and State, and briefly described as follows, to-wit:

(1) Deed dated November 13th, 1922, executed by Winnie I. Knoll, for a sewer right of way in Lot 248 of the Lands of the Southern California Colony Association.

(2) Deed dated November 20th, 1922, executed by E. O. Stansell and Agns Stansell, for a portion of Lot 199 of the Lands of the Southern California Colony Association, for the purpose of a public street,

be, and the same are hereby accepted for the purposes and intentions as therein set forth; and

Be it further resolved, that a copy of this resolution be attached to said deeds and that the same be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Riverside, and filed in the office of the City Engineer of said city.

I, Winnie I. Knoll, grant to the CITY OF RIVERSIDE, a Municipal Corporation of the State of California, an EASEMENT OF RIGHT-OF-WAY for the construction and maintenance of a public sewer over and through the following described premises, situate in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows, to-wit:

A strip of land four feet in width, lying two feet on each side of a line described as follows. Beginning at a point on the northerly line of Lot 248 of the Lands of the Southern California Colony Association, a map of which is recorded in Book 7 of maps, Page 3, Records of San Bernardino County California, said point being 213.26 feet easterly from the northwesterly corner of said Lot 248; thence southerly to a point 15 feet northerly from the southerly line and 214.2 feet easterly from the westerly line of said Lot 248; thence westerly to the most southwesterly corner of said Lot 248, a distance of 214.74 feet.

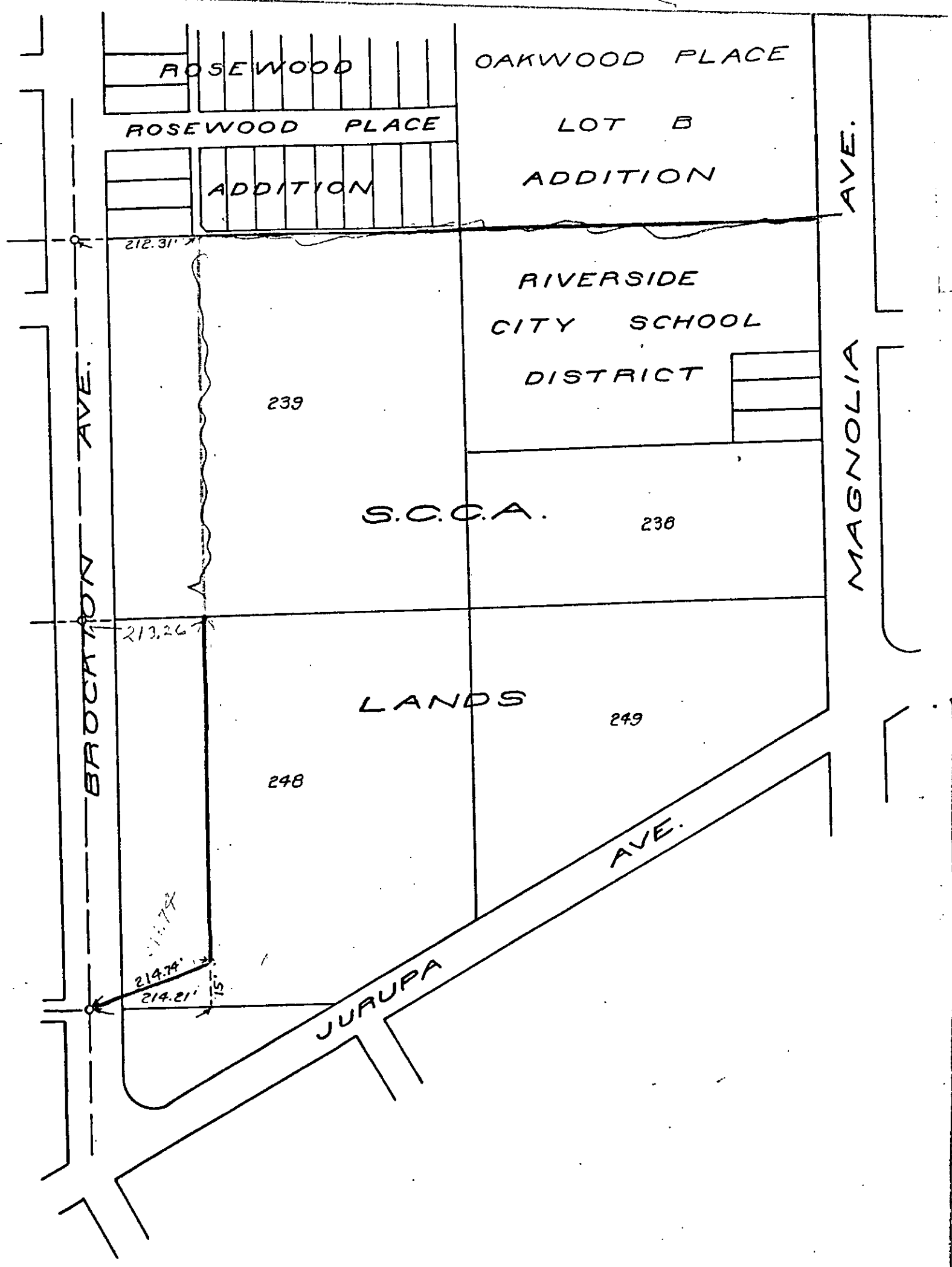
