WORDS OF GRANT: Remise, Release and forever quit-claim.

"A strip of land eighty feet in width, for a Public Highway, through ten-acre lots number seven (7) and one hundred and fifty-six (156) of the land of the S. C. C. A.

Said Public Highway being the same as viewed by Messers. Kenneston, Waite and C. C. Miller, and reported to said Board of Supervisors.

TOGETHER with all and singular, etc.

"FOREVER, or as long as the same may be used as a Public Highway."
