and to enjoy the use of said right of way free and clear of buildings,
trees or other obstructions.

RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE ACCEPTING A DEED FOR A RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR ELECTRIC POLES, LINES, WIRES ETC.

RESOLVED; by the Common Council of the City of Riverside, that deed dated June 1, 1927, executed by W. R. GOSS and LOTTIE V. GOSS to the City of Riverside, a municipal corporation, of the County of Riverside, State of California, for right-of-way for electric poles, lines, wires etc. across the following described premises situated in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:
