Chase, that said resolution, referred to of Decem-
ber 20th, 1910, is hereby amended to include the
vacation of the alleys in Block Five (5), Range
One (1), in addition to the alleys in Block Three
(3), R. One (1), as contemplated in the Agreement
with said railroad, of December 8th, 1908, and that
said resolution be also amended to exclude the
words "pole lines," inasmuch as the erection
of pole lines was not mentioned in said agree-
ment of December 8th, 1908, so that the resolution
is amended will read in full as follows:

In the matter of the vacation of the alleys
in Blocks Three (3) and Five (5), Range One (1) in
the City of Riverside, as contemplated by the
motion made at the meeting of the Common
Council on December 8th, 1908, and recorded on page
113, Vol. 10 of the Minutes of the City of Riverside,
Whereas, all of said Blocks 3 and 5, Range 1, are
owned by the San Pedro, Los Angeles & Salt Lake
Railroad Company, which railroad company desires
that said alleys be closed, and

Whereas, it is for the best interest and convenience
of said railroad company and the City that said alleys
be closed, reserving to the said City of Riverside
forever the right to place sewer pipes and other pipes
and conduits with their necessary wires and equip-
ment in said alleys whenever the necessity or
