WHEREAS, public convenience and welfare now require the use by the public of said real property for road purposes; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled this 13th day of June, 1955, that the offer of dedication of the real property hereinafter described, as set forth on the subdivision map hereinafter referred to, is accepted, and said real property is hereby declared open for the uses and purposes of county highways.

Said real property is described as follows:

All that portion of Lot "A", 40 feet in width, designated as Western Avenue, lying southwesterly of and contiguous to the southwesterly line of Lot 46, as said lots are shown on Map of Alhambra Addition as filed in Book 11, Pages 78 and 79 of Maps, records of Riverside County, California.

WHEREAS, the Traffic Safety Committee and the Road Commissioner of the County of Riverside have recommended illumination of the intersection of Van Buren Boulevard and Limonite Avenue for the safety of persons using said county highways; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND AND DETERMINED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled this 13th day of June, 1955, that the safety of persons using Van Buren Boulevard and Limonite Avenues requires illumination at the intersection of said county highways; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of this Board be and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the County of Riverside an agreement with the Southern California Edison Company providing for illumination at aforesaid intersection by the use of four 20,000 lumen mercury vapor street lights.
