R E S O L U T I O N

Upon motion of Supervisor Fittman, seconded by Supervisor Gilmore, and duly carried, the following resolution was adopted, to-wit:

WHEREAS, petition of Harman Kidd and P. W. Everington, et al., praying for the vacation and abandonment of certain roads in the Third Road District of Riverside County, as particularly described in said petition, having been heretofore duly and regularly set for hearing at this time, and

WHEREAS, it appearing from the affidavit of K. Irving Marshall, on file with this Board, that notices of the time and place of hearing said petition were posted along the line of roads proposed to be vacated, in conspicuous places, on the 23rd day of August, 1945, and it further appearing from the affidavit of Hazel C. Selby, on file with this Board, that notice of the time and place of the hearing of said petition was published in the Riverside News, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the County of Riverside, and the newspaper designated by this Board for the publication of said notice, on the following dates, to-wit:

August 23rd and 30th, October 6th, 1945, and

WHEREAS, no protests having been made or filed to the granting of said petition, and

WHEREAS, the Riverside County Planning Commission having made its recommendation to this Board, recommending that said petition be granted,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, AND DETERMINED, as follows, to-wit:

1. That said petition complies in all respects with the requirements of the law governing the vacation and abandonment of roads.
2. That notice of the filing of the petition, and the time and place at which the same would be heard, has been given, by posting and by publication for the time and in the manner required by law.
3. That those certain roads proposed to be vacated and abandoned are unnecessary for present and prospective use.
4. That the public easement heretofore existing in said roads shall hereinafter cease and determine, and the title to the land previously subject shall revert to the respective owners free from such easements.

The roads hereinabove referred to, and herein vacated and abandoned, are particularly described as follows, to-wit:

That portion of Spring Street extending from a line 50 feet westerly of the intersection of the center line of Pala Avenue to a line which lies 50 feet at right angles easterly from the southeasterly line of La Cadena Drive; said Lot and Streets are shown on Map of East Riverside, recorded in Map Book 7 at page 33 thereof, Records of the Recorder of San Bernardino County, California.
