

RELINQUISHMENT OF STATE HIGHWAY
IN THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, ROAD VIII-RIV-19-RIV

WHEREAS, the State of California has constructed an underpass of Road VIII-Riv-19-Riv, at Eighth Street in the City of Riverside for the tracks of the Union Pacific Railroad Company, the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and the Southern Pacific Company; and

WHEREAS, the State of California has acquired rights of way for and has reconstructed a certain city street and has constructed a new city street in connection with said underpass; and

WHEREAS, by a Cooperative Agreement dated January 29, 1957 and a Supplemental Agreement dated May 13, 1958 and by Second Supplemental Agreement dated September 16, 1958, the City has agreed to accept control and maintenance of said reconstructed city street and new city street upon relinquishment thereof to said city by the State of California; and

WHEREAS, this Commission has found and determined, and does hereby find and determine, that it is desirable and in the public interest that portions of said reconstructed city street and new city street be relinquished to the City of Riverside for use as city streets;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS VOTED by the California Highway Commission that it relinquish, and it does hereby relinquish to the City of Riverside, effective upon the recordation of a certified copy hereof with the Recorder of Riverside County, those portions of a reconstructed city street and a new city street in said city, together with the rights of way and appurtenances thereof, described as follows

All of the reconstructed city street and new city street adjacent to Road VIII-Riv-19-Riv shaded as shown on one map filed for record on March 31, 1960, in State Highway Map Book No. 2, Page 196, Records of Riverside County, described as follows:

SEGMENT 1 A triangular portion of land in Block 7, Range 1, of the City of Riverside, lying adjacent to the Westerly line of Santa Fe Avenue and between 90 feet Northerly of and opposite Engineer's Station 88+34.38 of the centerline of Improvement of the Department of Public Works' Survey of Road VIII-Riv 19 Riv, and the Easterly terminus being 125.98 feet Northerly of and opposite Station 88+45.22 of said survey.

SEGMENT 2 A portion of Lots 10, 11 and 12 of the Riverside Fruit Company's Subdivision in Block 8, Range 1, of the City of Riverside. The Westerly terminus being 161.51 feet Southerly of and opposite Engineer's Station 88+13.57 of said survey, and the Easterly terminus being 141.50 feet Southerly of and opposite Engineer's Station 88+99.06 of said survey.

The total length of State highway hereby relinquished is 0.02 of a mile.

The purpose of this resolution is to vest in the City of Riverside as city streets all of the State of California's right, title, and interest in and to the portions of State highway hereby relinquished.

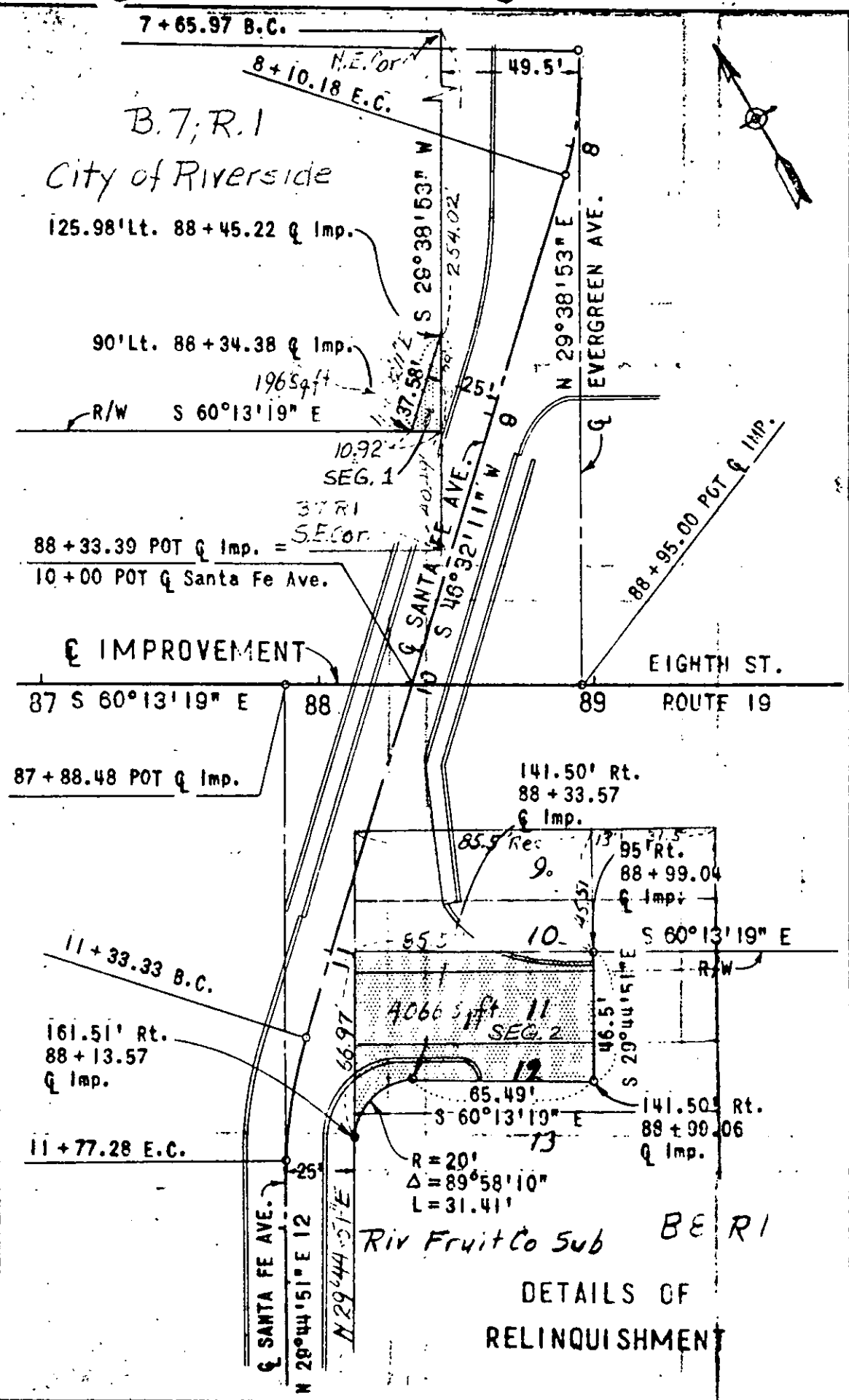
