A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, DEDICATING AND ACCEPTING CERTAIN CITY-OWNED LAND FOR PUBLIC STREET PURPOSES RELATING TO THE EXTENSION OF FRANCES STREET IN THE VICINITY OF THE MARY FRANCES RESERVOIR SITE IN CONNECTION WITH THE DEVELOPMENT OF TRACT 20811.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the following described strip or parcel of land located in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and owned by the City of Riverside, being a portion of the Mary Frances Reservoir site, is hereby dedicated by the City of Riverside for public use for street purposes to become and be known as a portion of Frances Street:

That portion of Block 65 of Arlington Heights, as shown by map on file in Book 11 of Maps, at pages 20 and 21 thereof, records of San Bernardino County, California, described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Northeasterly line of Mary Street, said point being 15.00 feet southeasterly from the intersection of the Northwesterly line of Frances Street, produced with said Northeasterly line of Mary Street, as shown on said Arlington Heights, said point being the most Southerly corner of that certain parcel of land conveyed to the City of Riverside by deed recorded November 25, 1913, in Book 385, page 366 of Deeds, records of Riverside County, California;

Thence North 34° 00' 00" West along the Northeasterly line of Mary Street, a distance of 12.11 feet;

Thence Easterly on a non-tangent curve concave Northerly, having a radius of 39.50 feet through an angle of 43° 27' 37", an arc length of 29.96 feet to the Southeasterly line of said parcel of land conveyed to the City of Riverside (the initial radial line bears South 12° 10' 48" West":

South 12° 10' 48" West";
