LICENSE

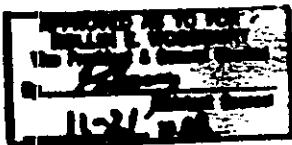
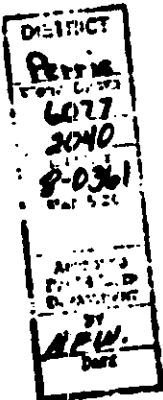
THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY, a corporation, organized under the laws of the State of California, and having its principal place of business at 140 New Montgomery Street, San Francisco, in said State, hereby grants to SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, a corporation, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, lay, install, use, maintain, alter, add to, repair, replace, inspect and/or remove, at any time and from time to time, aerial and underground electric lines and lines consisting of poles, guys and anchors, crossarms, wires, cables, conduits, manholes, vaults, pull boxes, markers and other fixtures and appliances, for conveying electric energy to be used for light, heat, power or other related uses, in, on, over, under and through that certain real property in the County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:

The West 6 feet of the East 208.71 feet of the South 248.71 feet of the East Half (E $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the South Half (S $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the West Half (W $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Lot 4, Block 4, Alessandro Tract, as shown by map thereof, recorded in Map Book 6, page 13, records of San Bernardino County, California.

EXCEPTING therefrom that portion lying southerly of a line 40 feet North of and parallel with the South line of Section 8, Township 3 South, Range 4 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian, as described in the Deed to Riverside County, recorded June 20, 1956, in Book 1930, page 507, Official Records of Riverside County, California.

This License is given upon and subject to the following terms, covenants and conditions:

1. Licensee, its successors and assigns, and its and their respective agents and employees, shall have the right to trim or top such trees as may endanger or interfere with said facilities, and shall have free access to said facilities and every part thereof, at all times, for the purpose of exercising the rights herein granted.

2. Licensee's rights hereunder shall be subject to all valid and existing easements, rights, leases, licenses, reservations and encumbrances whether of record or not affecting said property or any portion thereof.

3. Any facilities placed under this License shall be constructed in a careful and workmanlike manner and to the satisfaction of Licensor and in accordance with plans and specifications to be submitted to and approved by the Engineers of Licensor before work is commenced. All such work shall conform to all laws and regulations of the State of California, or any commission, board or municipality having jurisdiction thereover governing clearances and types of overhead construction.

4. In the event any facilities placed hereunder at any time interfere with or restricts the reasonable use of the property by Licensor, its successors or assigns, Licensee shall within sixty (60) days after written notice so to do, remove, reconstruct, alter or make changes in the location of said facilities in a manner satisfactory to Licensor, its successors or assigns.

(a) If said facilities are being used to provide electrical service exclusively to Licensor, its agents, tenants, successors or assigns, said removal, reconstruction, alteration or change shall be made at Licensor's sole expense.

(b) If said facilities are being used to provide electrical service exclusively to others than Licensor, its agents, tenants, successors or assigns, said removal, reconstruction, alteration or change in the location shall be done at licensee's sole expense.

(c) If said facilities are being used to provide electrical service to Licensor, its agents, tenants, successors or assigns, and others, a pro rata share of the cost of said removal, reconstruction, alteration or change shall be borne by Licensor. Said pro rata share of cost of said removal,

reconstruction, alteration or change shall be based upon the ratio that the proportion of Licensee's units of electrical service used to serve Licensor exclusively and required to be removed, reconstructed, altered or changed, bears to the total number of Licensee's units of electrical service used to serve Licensor and others and required to be removed, reconstructed, altered or changed.

5. This License shall not be revoked so long as said facilities placed hereunder is used by Licensee in whole or in part for the purpose of providing electrical service. However, when Licensee ceases to use said facilities for said purpose, either Licensor or Licensee may, by giving written notice to such effect to the other in the manner as provided herein, cancel this License and Licensee shall within sixty (60) days after receipt of said notice remove said facilities at its sole expense and restore the ground to as near its original condition and appearance as possible within said period of sixty (60) days.

6. Licensee agrees that it will not record this License.

7. The Notices provided in this License given by either party hereto to the other shall be deemed to have been duly given when made in writing and deposited in the United States mail, registered and postage prepaid, addressed as follows:

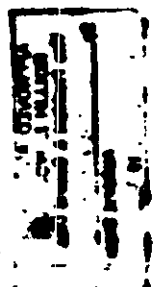

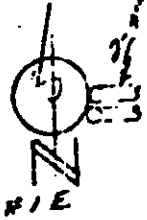
