WHEREAS on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted that the alley ordered vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the alley located southeasterly of California Avenue and southwesterly of Van

Buren Boulevard in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described in the document attached hereto, marked Exhibit A, and by this reference made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby vacated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the vacation shall occur only after the applicable conditions contained in the Planning Department's report to the legislative body dated August 13, 1986, and on file with the City Clerk have been satisfied; and the City Clerk is hereby directed not to record this resolution of vacation until the applicable conditions have been satisfied.
