2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, CHANGING THE NAME OF ALL THAT
4 PORTION OF SEVENTH STREET WITHIN THE CITY OF
5 RIVERSIDE LOCATED BETWEEN BUENA VISTA BRIDGE AND
6 EUCALYPTUS AVENUE TO MISSION INN AVENUE.

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7 WHEREAS the Mission Inn is located on what is now known
8 as Seventh Street in downtown Riverside; and

9 WHEREAS the Mission Inn is a designated National
10 Historic Landmark, as well as a designated state and local
11 landmark; and

12 WHEREAS the presence of the Mission Inn in downtown
13 Riverside has the potential to attract tourists and businesses
14 to the City of Riverside, thereby translating into an increase
15 in economic benefits to the downtown community, as well as the
16 City of Riverside as a whole; and

17 WHEREAS the renaming of Seventh Street to Mission Inn
18 Avenue would increase the freeway visibility and recognition of
19 the Mission Inn as a downtown Riverside commodity;

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of
21 the City of Riverside, California, that the name of all that
22 portion of SEVENTH STREET located between BUENA VISTA BRIDGE
23 and EUCALYPTUS AVENUE described as follows:

24 That portion of Seventh Street lying easterly of Buena
25 Vista Avenue as shown by map on file in Book 5 of Maps,
26 at page 150 thereof, records of Riverside County,
27 California, and lying westerly of Eucalyptus Avenue as
shown by map on file in Book 7 of Maps, at page 27
thereof, records of San Bernardino County, California.



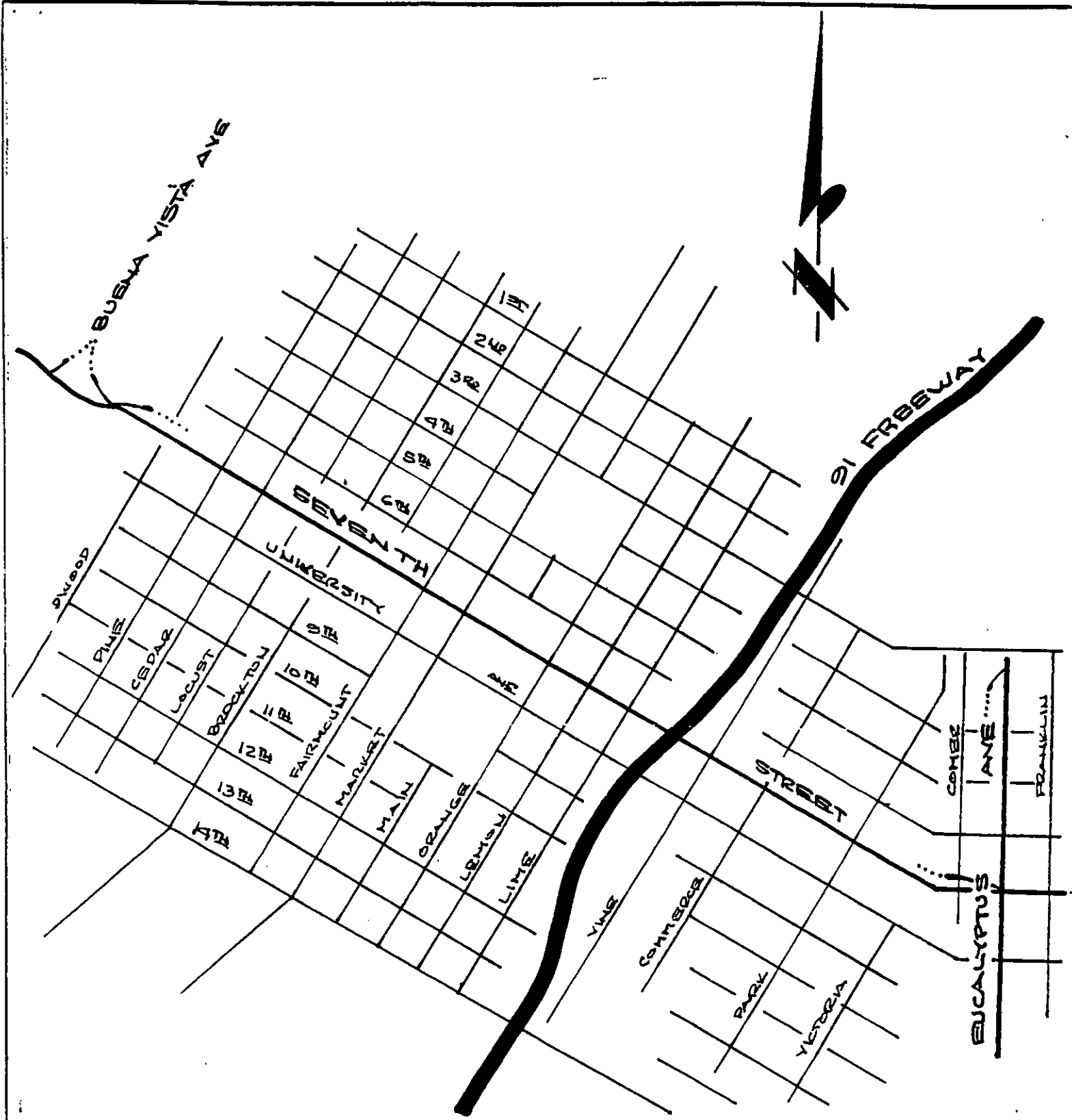
