

1 RESOLUTION NO. 8731

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND
4 DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF
5 INTENTION NO. 8704; RESERVING EASEMENTS AND
6 RIGHTS OF WAY, AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC
7 CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE RESERVATION OF
8 SUCH EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY; AND MAKING ITS
9 ORDER VACATING PEDESTRIAN WALKWAYS.

10 WHEREAS, on October 13, 1959, the City Council of the
11 City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 8704 declaring its
12 intention to order the vacation of pedestrian walkways, and
13 fixing the time and place for hearing all persons interested
14 in the proposed vacations, pursuant to the provisions of the
15 Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Sections 8300 et seq. of
16 Part 5, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the
17 State of California; and,

18 WHEREAS, said proposed vacation was submitted to and
19 acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside,
20 and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by
21 said Street Vacation Act of 1941; and,

22 WHEREAS, on the day fixed for the hearing, the City Council
23 heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested,
24 and found, and hereby finds true all of the evidence submitted that
25 the pedestrian walkways hereinafter ordered vacated are unnecessary
26 for present or prospective public use.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City
28 Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the pedestrian
29 walkways in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of
30 California, and described as follows:

31 Those certain pedestrian walkways 2.50 feet in
32 width, shown as Lots "P" and "Q" on map of San-
Air House Unit No. 2 on file in Book 28, page 66
of Maps, Records of Riverside County, California;

33 ACCEPTING AND RESERVING permanent easements and
rights of way as hereinafter mentioned,

34 and the same are hereby vacated.

1 I, Virginia J. Strohecker, City Clerk of the City
2 of Riverside, California, hereby certify that the foregoing
3 resolution was duly and regularly introduced and adopted by
4 the City Council of said City at its meeting held on the 10th
5 day of November, 1959, by the following vote, to wit:
