

RESOLUTION NO. 8756

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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 8736; RESERVING TO THE CITY EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY, AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE PRESERVATION OF SUCH EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY; AND MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING A PEDESTRIAN WALKWAY.

WHEREAS, on November 17, 1959, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 8736 declaring its intention to order the vacation of a pedestrian walkway, and fixing the time and place for hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Sections 3300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 3 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, said proposed vacation was submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside, and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by said Street Vacation Act of 1941; and,

WHEREAS, on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested and found, and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted that the pedestrian walkway hereinafter ordered vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the pedestrian walkway in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

That certain pedestrian walk 10.00 feet in width, shown as Lot "I" on Map of Magnolia Park Tract, on file in Book 22, page 52 of Maps, Records of Riverside County, California.

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING permanent easements and rights of way as hereinafter mentioned,

the and the same is hereby vacated.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby
2 determine that the public convenience and necessity require the
3 reservation of permanent easements and rights of way to construct,
4 maintain, operate, replace, remove and renew sanitary sewers,
5 and storm drains and appurtenant structures in, upon, over and
6 adjacent to pedestrian walkway vacated, and reserving the right
7 to install, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and
8 enlarge lines of pipes, conduits, cables, wires, poles and other
9 conduits, conduits, equipment and fixtures for the operation
10 of gas pipe lines, telegraphic and telephone lines, and for the
11 transportation and distribution of electric energy, petroleum
12 and gas products, water, and incidental purposes, including
13 access, and the right to keep the property free from inflammable
14 materials, and to maintain, and otherwise protect the same from
15 all hazards in, upon and over the part of said pedestrian walk-
16 way vacated.

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18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City of
19 Riverside shall make a certified copy of this order, attested
20 by the City Clerk under the seal of said City, to be recorded
21 in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County,
22 California.

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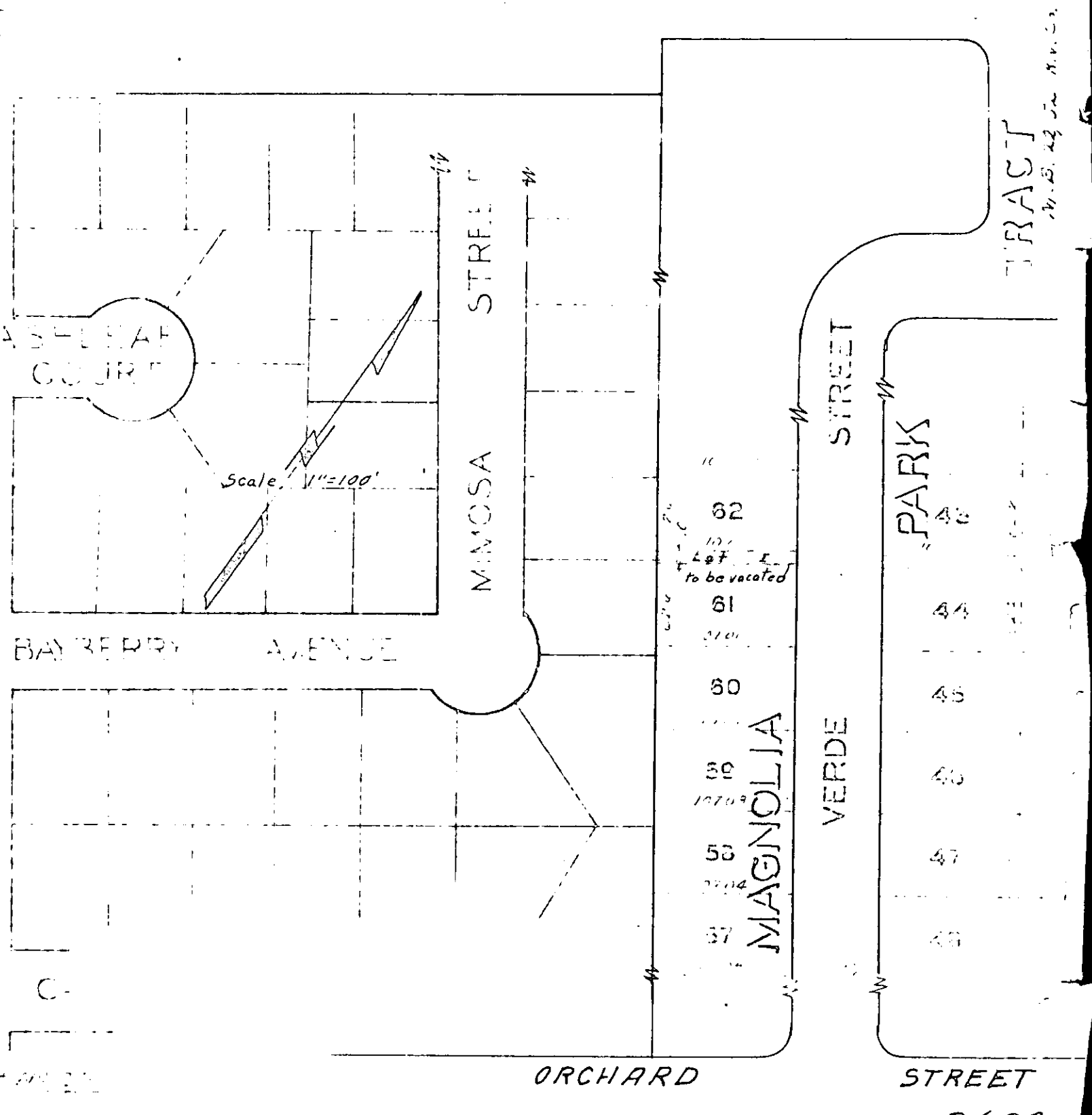
