

RESOLUTION NO. 8774

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 8743 ; RESERVING EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY, AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE RESERVATION OF SUCH EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY; AND MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING PEDESTRIAN WALKWAYS.

WHEREAS, On November 24, 1959, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 8743 declaring its intention to order the vacation of pedestrian walkways, and fixing the time and place for hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Sections 8300 et seq. of Part 5, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, said proposed vacation was submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside, and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by said Street Vacation Act of 1941; and,

WHEREAS, on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested, and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted that the pedestrian walkways hereinafter ordered vacated are unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the pedestrian walkways in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

Those certain pedestrian ways ten (10) feet in width, shown as Lots "D" and "E" on map of Jefferson Square on file in Book 23, page 61 of Maps, Records of Riverside County, California;

EXCEPTING AND RESERVING permanent easements and rights of way hereinafter mentioned,

be and the same are hereby vacated.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby
2 determine that the public convenience and necessity require the
3 reservation of permanent easements and rights of way to con-
4 struct, maintain, operate, replace, remove and renew sanitary
5 sewers, and storm drains and appurtenant structures in, upon,
6 over and across the pedestrian walkways vacated, and reserving
7 the right to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove,
8 renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles
9 and other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures for the
10 operation of gas pipe lines, telegraphic and telephone lines,
11 and for the transportation and distribution of electric energy,
12 petroleum and its products, water, and incidental purposes
13 including access, and the right to keep the property free from
14 inflammable materials, and weed growth, and otherwise protect
15 the same from all hazards in, upon and over the part of said
16 pedestrian walkways vacated.
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18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City
19 of Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, at-
20 tested by the City Clerk under the seal of said City, to be
21 recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside
22 County, California.
