RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 8554, RESERVING EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY PROVIDED IN SECTION 8330 OF THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE, AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE RESERVATION OF SUCH EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 8331 OF SAID CODE; AND ORDER OF VACATION IN THE MATTER OF VACATING ALLEYS.

WHEREAS, on April 21, 1959, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 8554 declaring its intention to order the vacation of alleys, and fixing the time and place for hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Sections 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, said proposed vacation was submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside, and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by said Street Vacation Act of 1941; and,

WHEREAS, on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested, and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted that the said alleys hereinafter ordered vacated are unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the said alleys in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

Those portions of Block 8, Range 2 Town of Riverside, as added to the City of Riverside for alley purposes and more particularly described as follows:

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2 The northeasterly 15.00 feet of Lots 6
3 and 9 and the southeasterly 10.00 feet of
4 Lots 9, 10 and 11 and the northwesterly
5 10.00 feet of Lots 6, 7 and 8; all as
6 shown on Map of the Town of Riverside re-
7 corded in Book 7, page 17 of Maps, Records
8 of San Bernardino County, California;

10 **EXCEPTING AND RESERVING** permanent easements
11 and rights of way as hereinafter mentioned,

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13 are unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and
14 that the same be and are hereby vacated.

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16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council does hereby
17 determine that the public convenience and necessity require the
18 reservation of permanent easements and rights of way to construct,
19 maintain, operate, replace, remove and renew sanitary sewers,
20 and storm drains and appurtenant structures in, upon, over and
21 across the said alleys vacated, and reserving the right to
22 construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge
23 lines of pipe, conduit, cables, wires, poles and other convenient
24 structures, equipment and fixtures for the operation of gas
25 pipe lines, telegraphic and telephone lines, and for the trans-
26 portation and distribution of electric energy, petroleum and
27 its products, water and incidental purposes, including access,
28 and the right to keep the property free from inflammable
29 materials, and wood growth, and otherwise protect the same from
30 all hazards in, upon and over the said alleys vacated.

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32 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the City Clerk of said City of
Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested
by the City Clerk under the seal of said City, to be recorded in
the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.
