

WAIVER OF VEHICULAR ACCESS

For a valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY, a California Corporation, hereby waives and relinquishes all rights of vehicular ingress and egress to and from Parcel 1 of the land as shown in City of Riverside Record of Survey No.564 and Lafayette Street, a public street in the City of Riverside, and the party covenants and agrees that they will permit no vehicular ingress or egress to or from said Parcel 1 and said Lafayette Street.

Parcel 1 of City of Riverside Record of Survey 564 consists of a parcel of real property located on the southwest corner of Lafayette Street and Jackson Street in the City of Riverside and the same is shown upon the said Record of Survey as a portion of Lot 33, Block 12 of the Village of Arlington, map Book 1, page 62, Records of San Bernardino County.

This waiver of access shall be binding on the successors and assigns of The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company. City of Riverside Record of Survey 564 will be recorded concurrently with the recordation of this waiver of vehicular access.
