

WAIVER OF VEHICULAR ACCESS

For a valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, GENERAL HOME MISSION COMMITTEE OF THE CHRISTIAN REFORM CHURCH, a Michigan Corporation, hereby waives and relinquishes all rights of vehicular ingress and egress to and from Parcel 1 of the land as shown in City of Riverside Record of Survey No. 604 and Jackson Street, a public street in the City of Riverside, and the party covenants and agrees that they will permit no vehicular ingress or egress to or from said Parcel 1 and said Jackson Street.

Parcel 1 of City of Riverside Record of Survey consists of a parcel of real property located on the northeast corner of Jackson Street and Colorado Avenue in the City of Riverside and the same is shown upon the said Record of Survey as a portion of Lot 13, in Block 3 of Riverside Land and Irrigating Company Lands, Book 1, page 70, San Bernardino County Records.

This waiver of access shall be binding on the successors and assigns of General Home Mission Committee of the Christian Reform Church. City of Riverside Record of Survey No. 604 will be recorded concurrently with the recordation of this waiver of vehicular access.
