

RESOLUTION NO. 9387

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2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND
4 DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF
5 INTENTION NO. 9353 ; RESERVING EASEMENTS AND
6 RIGHTS OF WAY AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC
7 CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE RESERVATION
8 OF SUCH EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY; AND MAKING
9 ITS ORDER VACATING A PORTION OF BEAU AVENUE.

10 WHEREAS, on February 13, 1962, the City Council of the
11 City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 9353 declaring its
12 intention to order the vacation of a portion of Beau Avenue, and
13 fixing the time and place of hearing all persons interested in
14 the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Street
15 Vacation Act of 1941, being Sections 8300 et seq. of Part 3,
16 Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of
17 California; and

18 WHEREAS, said proposed vacation was submitted to and
19 acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside
20 and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by
21 said Street Vacation Act of 1941; and

22 WHEREAS, on the day fixed for the hearing the City
23 Council heard and considered the evidence offered by persons
24 interested and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence
25 submitted that the said portion of said street hereinafter ordered
26 vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City
28 Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the said
29 portion of Beau Avenue in the City of Riverside, County of River-
30 side, State of California, described as follows:

31 All that part of that certain street 66.0 feet
32 in width known as Beau Avenue, as the same is shown
as Lot "E" of Camp Anza Subdivision No.1 on map on
file in Book 22, at page 81 of Maps, Records of
Riverside County, California, described as follows:

All of the westerly 440.06 feet of the easterly
740.06 feet of said Lot "E" of Camp Anza Subdivision
No.1.

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Reserving all permanent easements and rights of way of every nature as provided in Section 8330 and 8331 of the Streets and Highways Code over, across, upon or under the portion of said street above described,

be and the same is hereby vacated.

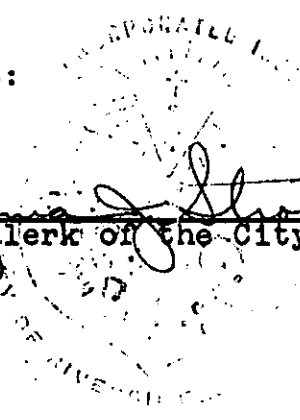
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby determine that the public convenience and necessity require the reservation of permanent easements and rights of way to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove and renew sanitary sewers and storm drains and appurtenant structures in, upon, over and across the portion of said street to be vacated, and reserving the right to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles and other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures for the operation of gas pipe lines, telegraphic and telephone lines and for the transportation and distribution of electric energy, petroleum and its products, water and incidental purposes including access and the right to keep the property free from inflammable materials and wood growth and otherwise protect the same from all hazards in, upon and over the said portion of said street to be vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City of Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested by the City Clerk under the seal of said City, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.
