

RESOLUTION NO. 9397

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, CHANGING STREET NAMES.

WHEREAS the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside has recommended and the City Council has determined that it is to the best interests of the City that the names of the hereinafter designated streets be changed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside that the names of the hereinafter designated streets are changed as follows:

LEWIS STREET

All of that certain street 66 feet in width now known as Lewis Street, being all of Lot B of Glenhaven Knolls Unit No.1 as shown on map on file in Book 40, pages 4 and 5 of Maps, Records of Riverside County, California,

be changed to LEEDS STREETS .

SHORT STREET

All of that certain street of a uniform width of 60 feet now known as Short Street, lying north of the northerly line of Jurupa Avenue as shown on map of Mc Claskey Tract as said map is on file in Book 10, pages 36 and 37 of Maps, Records of Riverside County, California,

be changed to ROMNEY STREET.

EAST TREY AVENUE and WEST TREY AVENUE

All of those certain streets of variable width now known as East Trey Avenue and West Trey Avenue, being all of Lots Z and B respectively of Camp Anza Subdivision No.1, as shown on map on file in Book 22, page 81 of Maps, Records of Riverside County, California,

be changed to TREY AVENUE.

PALOMA AVENUE

All of the existing portion of that certain street of variable width now known as Paloma Avenue lying westerly of and adjacent to Lots 1 and 11 of La Granada Tract and lying between the southerly line of Bolton Avenue and the northerly line of Tomlinson Avenue, said La Granada Tract being shown on map on file in Book 12, pages 42 to 51 inclusive of Maps, Records of Riverside County, California,

be changed to ALCAZAR AVENUE.
