of the County of Los Angeles, State of California, for and in the actual con- sideration of the sum of (\$1.00) Dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant to the COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, the following described property situated in the County of Riverside, State of California, to-wit:

A strip of land 25 feet wide, measured at right angles, by 90 feet long and a strip of land 25 feet wide by 18 feet long, lying north of and adjoining the northerly line of Arlington Avenue as conveyed to Riverside County by deed recorded February 4, 1925, in Book 629, page 55 of Deeds, records of the Recorder of Riverside County, California, more particularly described as follows:

All that portion of that certain parcel acquired by W. A. Gals by deed recorded November 9, 1921 in Book 1318 page 65, Official Records of the Recorder of Riverside County, California, lying southerly of a line 55 feet northerly from and parallel with the center line of Arlington Avenue.
