G.A. REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION RESOLUTION.

On motion of Supervisor Hayden, seconded by Supervisor Lewis,

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and duly carried, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, each parcel of the real property hereinafter described was heretofore offered for dedication to public use for road purposes as set forth on the subdivision maps hereinafter referred to, which offers of dedication have not heretofore been accepted by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, public convenience and welfare now require the use by the public of said real property for road purposes; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled this 8 th day of September 1952, that the offers of dedication of the real property hereinafter described, as set forth on the subdivision maps hereinafter referred to, are accepted, and each parcel of said real property is hereby declared open for the uses and purposes of county roads. Said real property is located in the County of Riverside, State of California, and is described as follows:

1. Alamo Street, as shown on map of the Alamo Tract, as filed in Book 9, Page 5 of Maps, in the Office of the Recorder of Riverside County, California.
2. A 30 foot wide unnamed street lying between Lots 5 and 6, and Lots 18 and 17, now known as Michigan Avenue; a 30 foot wide strip of land lying southerly of and contiguous to the southerly line of Lots 12 through 22, now known as Center Street; the above lots and streets are shown on the Map of Mrs. M. M. Kendall's Subdivision, filed in Book 8, Page 40 of Maps, in the Office of the Recorder of San Bernardino County, California.
3. Garfield Avenue and Spring Street, as shown on Map of Fairmount Park, filed in Book 11, Page 15 of Maps, in the Office of the Recorder of San Bernardino County, California.
4. A 30 foot wide unnamed street, now known as Center Street, lying northerly of and contiguous to the northerly line of Blocks 1 through 6; a 30 foot wide unnamed street, now known as Spring Street, lying southerly of and contiguous to the southerly line of Blocks 7 through 12; a 60 foot wide unnamed street, now known as Murphy Avenue, lying between Blocks 2 and 3, and Blocks 11 and 10; a 60 foot wide unnamed street, now known as Mt. Vernon Avenue, lying between Blocks 4 and 5, and Blocks 9 and 8, as said streets and blocks are shown on map of Plan of Subdivision for M. A. Murphy, filed in Book 8, Page 66 of Maps, in the Office of the Recorder of San Bernardino County, California.
5. Spring Street, as shown on Map of Herrick's Subdivision, filed in Book 3, Page 11 of Maps, in the Office of the Recorder of Riverside County, California.
