

RESOLUTION NO. 9475

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING A PORTION OF ALESSANDRO BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, on June 5, 1962, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 9438 declaring its intention to order the vacation of a portion of Alessandro Boulevard and fixing the time and place for hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Section 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, said proposed vacation was submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside, and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by said Street Vacation Act of 1941; and,

WHEREAS, on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested and found, and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted that the street hereinafter ordered vacated is unnecessary for present and prospective use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the portion of the street located in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

All that portion of Alessandro Boulevard (formerly Victoria-Elsinore Road) as shown on plat of Tequesquite Heights on file in Book 10, page 31 of Maps, Records of Riverside County, California, lying easterly of the following described line:

Commencing at the intersection of the center line of Chicago Avenue with the easterly line of said Alessandro Boulevard, as shown on plat of Tract #2264 on file in Book 43, pages 54 through 56, inclusive, records of said County;

Thence south 21° 17' east (recorded south 21° 16' east) 419.40 feet along said easterly line to the beginning of a tangent curve therein concave north-easterly, having a radius of 450 feet;

1 Thence southeasterly along said curve an arc
2 distance of 181.47 feet through a central angle of
3 $23^{\circ} 06' 20''$ (recorded $23^{\circ} 11'$);

4 Thence tangent to said curve on a bearing of
5 south $44^{\circ} 23' 20''$ east (recorded south $44^{\circ} 27'$ east)
6 87.99 feet along said easterly line to the true point
7 of beginning;

8 Thence south $33^{\circ} 07'$ east, 172.63 feet to the
9 beginning of a tangent curve concave southwesterly,
10 having a radius of 1,555.00 feet;

11 Thence southerly along last said curve an arc
12 distance of 111.88 feet through a central angle of
13 $40^{\circ} 07' 20''$ to the end of this line description,

14 is unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and that
15 the same be and is hereby vacated.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said
17 City of Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order,
18 attested by the City Clerk under the seal of said City, to be
19 recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside
20 County, California.

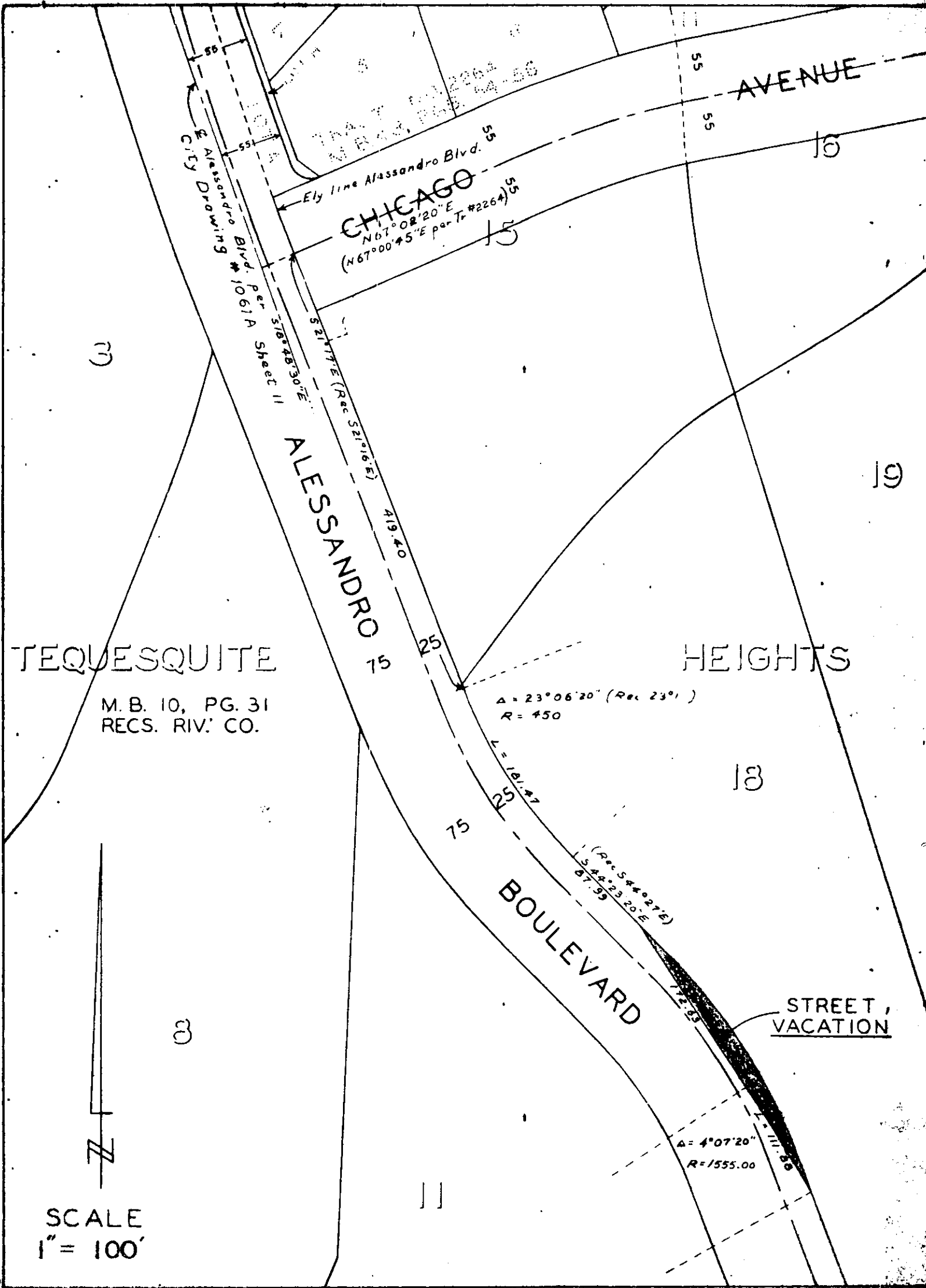
