RESOLUTION.

Upon motion of Supervisor Jones, seconded by Supervisor Hill, and duly carried, the following Resolution was adopted, to-wit:

WHEREAS, the following described public road in the County of Riverside, was heretofore deeded to the County of Riverside as a public road but not formally accepted by the Board of Supervisors as a county road; and,

WHEREAS, the public convenience and welfare require that said public road be accepted into the system of county highways in the County of Riverside;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled this 14th day of August, 1950, that the following described public road be and the same is hereby accepted into the County Highway System and is hereby declared to be a county highway;

That said road heretofore deeded as a public road, is shown as a portion of Lot 7, Block 61 on Map of La Sierra Heights Tract No. 2, filed in Map Book 7, at page 66, records of the Recorder of Riverside County, California, and is to be known and identified as "GREENLEAF DRIVE".

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors be and he is hereby instructed to file and record a copy of this Resolution.
