On motion of Supervisor Anderson and duly carried, the following resolution was adopted:

RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session convened this 25th day of April, 1955, that the following portion of Walls Avenue, a county highway, which has been superfluous to public use, being no longer necessary for county highway purposes, be hereby summarily vacated and abandoned. The portions comprising the portions of said highway hereby vacated and abandoned are in the County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:

All that portion of Lot UV, designated as Ullia Avenue, as shown on Map of La Granada, as filed in Book 22, page 42 through 51 of Maps, as approved by the County by deed recorded August 2, 1923, in Book 420 of Deeds, and by deed recorded in Book 820, page 423, Official Records of Riverside County, California, lying northerly of and contiguous to the northeasterly line of Lots 5, 6, 7, 8, Block 32, as shown on said Map of La Granada, and lying southeasterly of the southeasterly line of Ullia Avenue, 80 feet in width, 40 feet in right angle distance on either side of the following described center line:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of said Lot UV and Lot WH, as shown on said Map of La Granada;

Thence N. 43° 56' East, a distance of 28.94 feet;

Thence northeasterly on the arc of an 800 foot radius curve, concave to the northwest, through an angle of 32° 01' for an arc distance of 447.04 feet;

Thence N. 11° 55' East, a distance of 154.25 feet;

Thence northeasterly on the arc of a 700 foot radius curve, concave to the southeast, through an angle of 72° 20' for an arc distance of 883.72 feet.

by Supervisor Varner, and duly carried, the follow-
ing resolution was adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County
of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled
this 25th day of April, 1955, that the following described portions
of Wells Avenue, a county highway, which have been superseded by
relocation, being no longer necessary for county highway purposes,
are hereby summarily vacated and abandoned. The real property com-
prising the portions of said highway hereby vacated and abandoned
is in the County of Riverside, State of California, described as
follows:

All that portion of Lot UU, designated as Wells Avenue,
as shown on Map of La Granada, as filed in Book 12,
pages 42 through 51 of Maps, as conveyed to Riverside
County by deed recorded August 2, 1926, in Book 684,
Page 468 of Deeds, and by deed recorded April 9, 1947,
in Book 820, page 423, Official Records of Riverside
County, California, lying northwesterly of and con-
tiguous to the northwesterly line of Lots 5, 6, 7 and
8, Block 32, as shown on said Map of La Granada, and
lying southeasterly of the southeasterly right of way
line of Wells Avenue, 80 feet in width, 40 feet in
right angle distance on either side of the following
described center line:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of
said Lot UU and Lot WW, as shown on said Map of La
Granada;

Thence N.43°56' East, a distance of 28.94 feet;

Thence northeasterly on the arc of an 800 foot radius
curve, concave to the northwest, through an angle of
32°01' for an arc distance of 447.04 feet;

Thence N. 11°55' East, a distance of 154.25 feet;

Thence northeasterly on the arc of a 700 foot radius curve,
concave to the southeast, through an angle of 72°20' for
an arc distance of 883.72 feet.
