RESOLUTION ADOPTED GRANTING PETITION OF V. E. COSSENTINE & EARL F. AMBS, ET AL, TO VACATE ROAD IN 1ST DISTRICT.

4. That the public easement heretofore existing in said roads shall hereinafter cease and determine, and the title to the land previously subject shall revert to the respective owners free from such easements.

The roads hereinabove referred to, and herein vacated and abandoned, are particularly described as follows, to-wit:

ROAD KNOWN AS "A" STREET OFFICIALLY NAMED "RIVERVIEW DRIVE".

IT WAS ORDERED that the "A" Street extension as conveyed to Riverside County by deed recorded on July 9, 1940, in Book 467 of Official Records, at Page 519 thereof, be officially known and designated as "A" Street.

IT WAS FURTHER ORDERED that the existing county road running Northerly from Mission Blvd. along the Westerly line of Lots 11 and 18 of the Miller & Newman Survey of the Rubidoux Rancho to the Southerly line of Lot 8 of the Arthur Parks Tract, thence Easterly along the Southerly line of said Lot 8 to the Southeast corner thereof, connecting with the Westerly line of the county road designated as "A" Street, be officially known and designated as "Riverview Drive".
