BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on October 22, 1958, that ~~the~~ a portion of ~~the~~ the county highway known as Jones Avenue, and hereinafter described, is unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and all right therein is hereby abandoned, reserving and excepting the easement and right of way therein for existing and future public utility, public service and drainage facilities and structures pursuant to Section 9591 of the Streets and Highways Code, said abandonment being in the County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows.

Jones Avenue between Hole and Collette Avenues.
