2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND  
4 DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF  
5 INTENTION NO. 10416; RESERVING EASEMENTS AND  
6 RIGHTS OF WAY AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC  
7 CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE RESERVATION  
8 OF SUCH EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY: AND MAKING  
9 ITS ORDER VACATING AN ALLEY IN BLOCK 13, RANGE 4  
10 OF THE TOWN OF RIVERSIDE.

11 WHEREAS on December 7, 1965, the City Council of the City  
12 of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 10416 declaring its inten-  
13 tion to order the vacation of an alley in Block 13, Range 4 of  
14 the Town of Riverside and fixing the time and place of hearing  
15 all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to  
16 the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being  
17 Sections 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and  
18 Highways Code of the State of California; and

19 WHEREAS said proposed vacation was submitted to and  
20 acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside  
21 and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by  
22 said Street Vacation Act of 1941; and

23 WHEREAS on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council  
24 heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested  
25 and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted  
26 that the alley ordered vacated is unnecessary for present or  
27 prospective public use.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City  
29 Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the said alley  
30 in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of  
31 California, described as follows:

32 All that certain public alley being 15 feet wide in  
Block 13, Range 4 of the Town of Riverside, as shown  
by map on file in Book 7, page 17 of Maps, Records  
of San Bernardino County, California, said alley also  
being located between Lemon Street and Lime Street  
and southwesterly of the southwesterly line of  
Thirteenth Street;

EXCEPT THEREFROM an easement for sewer purposes  
lying within that certain alley to be vacated;

be and the same is hereby vacated.

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


1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby  
 2 determine that the public convenience and necessity require the  
 3 reservation of permanent easements and rights of way to con-  
 4 struct, maintain, operate, replace, remove and renew sanitary  
 5 sewers and storm drains and appurtenant structures in, upon,  
 6 over and across the above described alley to be vacated, and  
 7 reserving the right to construct, maintain, operate, replace,  
 8 remove, renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables,  
 9 poles and other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures  
 10 for the operation of gas pipe lines, telegraphic and telephone  
 11 lines, and for the transportation and distribution of electric  
 12 energy, petroleum and its products, water and incidental  
 13 purposes, including access and the right to keep the property  
 14 free from inflammable materials and wood growth and otherwise  
 15 protect the same from all hazards in, upon and over the above  
 16 described alley to be vacated.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City  
 18 of Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested  
 19 by the City Clerk under the seal of said City to be recorded  
 20 in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County,  
 21 California.

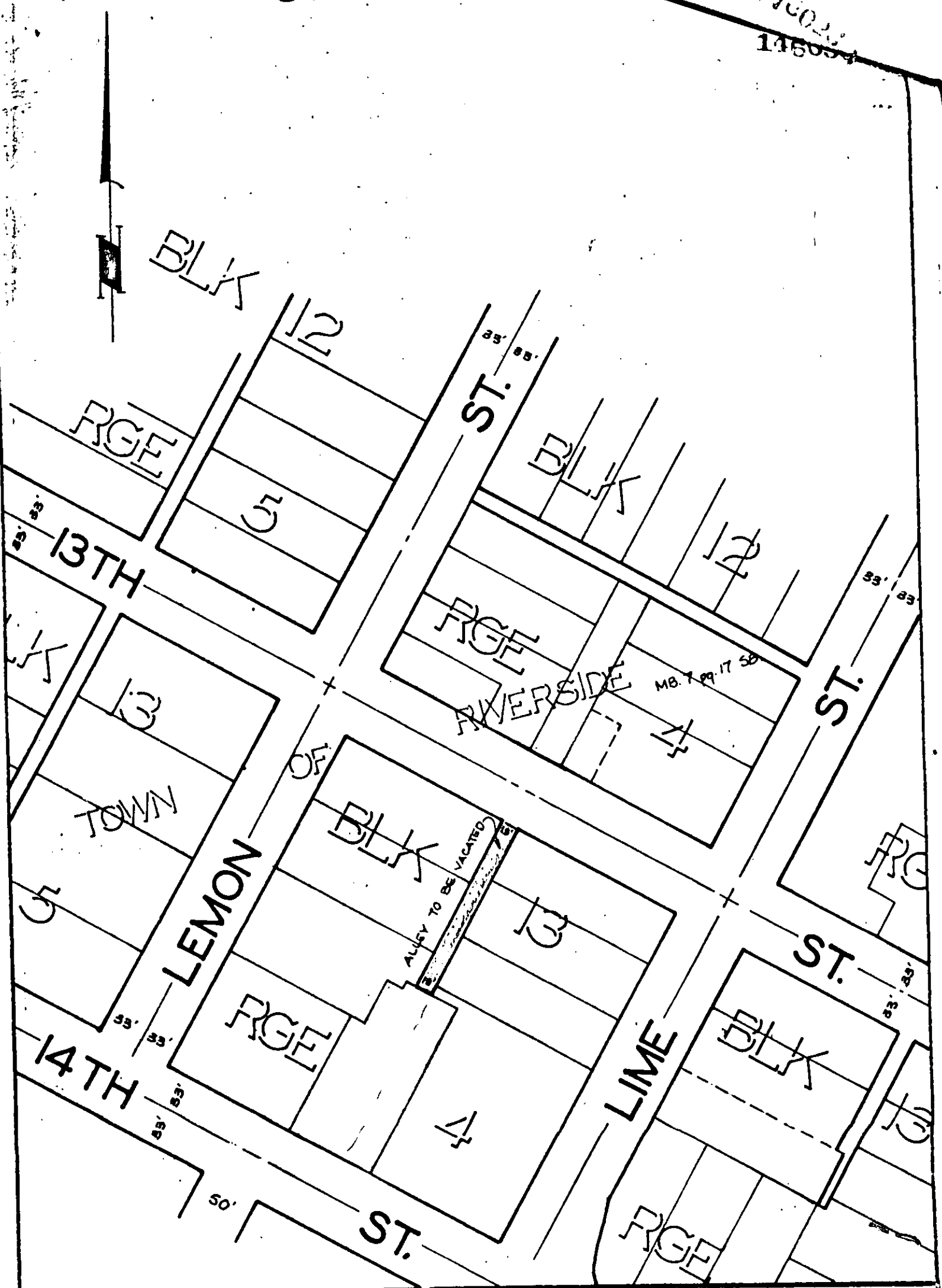
