

RESOLUTION NO. 10553

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING HIS ORDER VACATING AN ALLEY WITHIN BLOCK 15 OF RIVERVIEW ADDITION TRACT NO.3.

WHEREAS on May 17, 1966, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 10537 declaring its intention to order the vacation of an alley within Block 15 of Riverview Addition Tract No.3 and fixing the time and place of hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Sections 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested and found, and hereby finds, from all of the evidence submitted that the alley hereby ordered vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that said alley in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:

That certain alley 15 feet wide lying within Block 15 of Riverview Addition Tract No.3 as shown by map on file in Book 7, page 5 of Maps, Records of Riverside County, California, lying northerly of the northerly line of the Union Pacific Railroad, together with the easterly 2.5 feet of Lots 10, 11 and 12 of said Block 15 as granted to the City of Riverside by deed recorded March 20, 1964, in Book 3643, page 371 of Official Records of Riverside County, California; EXCEPTING therefrom the northerly 13 feet of the above described parcels,

is unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and the same is hereby vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City of Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested by the City Clerk under the seal of said City, to be recorded in

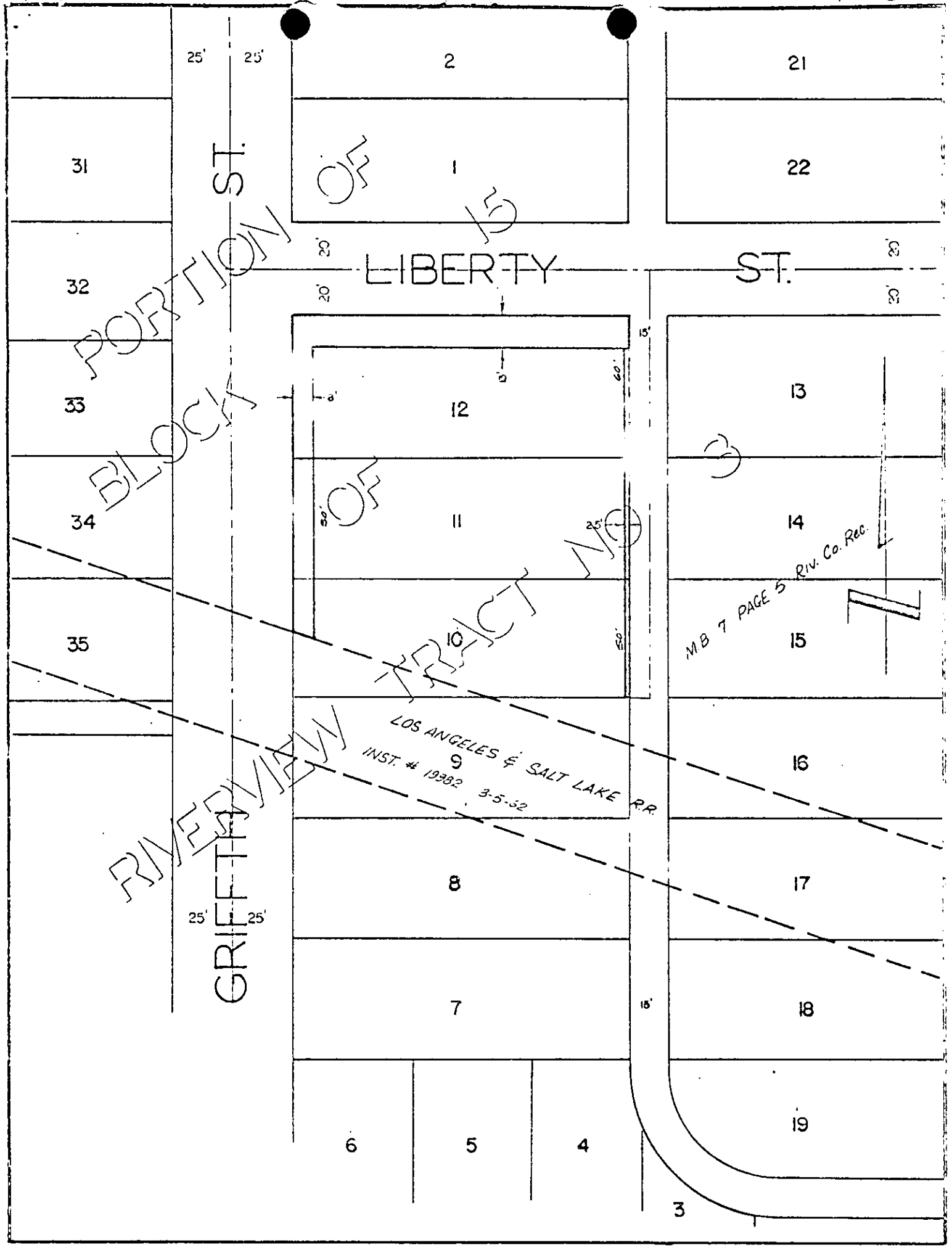
