A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING AN ALLEY WITHIN THE B. S. FINCH SUBDIVISION.

WHEREAS on May 31, 1966, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 10545 declaring its intention to order the vacation of an alley within the B. S. Finch Subdivision, and fixing the time and place of hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Sections 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested and found, and hereby finds, from all of the evidence submitted that said alley hereinafter ordered vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that said alley in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:

All of that certain 10 foot wide alley lying within the B. S. Finch Subdivision as shown by map on file in Book 4, page 87 of Maps, Records of Riverside County, California;

EXCEPTING therefrom the northeasterly 17 feet thereof as measured at right angles to Fourteenth Street (66 feet wide) as shown on said map,

is unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and the same be and is hereby vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City of Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested by the City Clerk under the seal of said City, to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.
