

RESOLUTION ABANDONING COUNTY HIGHWAY

WHEREAS, a public hearing upon a proposal to abandon (the right to accept a dedication of) (a portion of) the county highway known as Jurupa Road, in the Third Road District, as hereinafter described, was regularly held on this date after notice duly given, all evidence given by persons interested has been heard and considered, and the planning commission has made its report on said proposal; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled this 10th day of June, 1957, that the (portion of the) said county highway hereinafter described is unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and all right therein is abandoned, reserving and excepting the easement and right of way therein for existing and future public utility, public service and drainage facilities and structures pursuant to Section 359.1 of the Streets and Highways Code, the abandoned portion of said highway being in the County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

All that portion of Jurupa Road as shown on Map of the Alamo Tract, as filed in Book 9, Page 5 of Maps, records of Riverside County, described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the center-line of Rialto Road, 60 feet in width, now known as North Main Street, and the Jurupa Ranch Line, as shown on said Map of the Alamo Tract;

Thence westerly along said Jurupa Ranch Line, being also the San Bernardino-Riverside County Line, a distance of 597.57 feet to the southeasterly right of way line of the Highgrove Storm Channel;

Thence S. 61° 40' 17" West, along said southeasterly right of way line of the Highgrove Storm Channel, to the southerly line of said Jurupa Road, 50 feet in width;

Thence easterly along said southerly line of Jurupa Road to said center-line of Rialto Road;

Thence northerly along said center-line of Rialto Road to the point of beginning.

EXCEPTING therefrom that portion within said Rialto Road.
