RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,
CALIFORNIA, DESIGNATING A CERTAIN UNNAMED PUBLIC
STREET IN SAID CITY "MEGGINSON LANE".

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission of the City of Riverside has called to the attention of the City Council the existence of an unnamed public street, forty feet in width, in said city, which street is situated along the westerly side of F. M. Dunbar Subdivision, of record in Book 5, page 185, of Maps, records of Riverside County, California, and extends in a northerly direction from its intersection with the northerly line of Magnolia Avenue; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that public interest, convenience and necessity require that all public streets in said city shall be properly identified;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that that certain unnamed public street in the City of Riverside hereinabove described be, and the same is hereby, designated and named "MEGGINSON LANE", and the same shall hereafter be known as such.

I, G. Albert Mills, City Clerk of the City of Riverside, California, hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was duly and regularly introduced and adopted by the Council of said city, at its meeting held on the 11th day of January, 1944, by the following vote:
