RESOLUTION NO. 1823 (NEW SERIES).  
RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT CLOSING UP AND VACATING OF  
PORTIONS OF ST. LAWRENCE STREET HAS BEEN COMPLETED.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Riverside, did on the 19th day of May, 1931, pass its Resolution No. 1821 (New Series) ordering the work of closing up and vacating that portion of St. Lawrence Street in said City hereinafter described, as contemplated by Resolution of Intention No. 1806 (New Series); and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Council that the work of closing up and vacating said portion of St. Lawrence Street has been done and completed;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Council hereby determines that that portion of St. Lawrence Street in said City hereinafter described, is closed up and vacated.

The portion of St. Lawrence Street in said City hereinafter referred to is described as follows, to-wit:

That portion of St. Lawrence Street from Victoria Avenue to Cleveland Avenue and from Cleveland Avenue to Dufferin Avenue.
