RESOLUTION ABANDONING COUNTY HIGHWAY

WHEREAS, a public hearing upon a proposal to abandon (the right to accept dedication of) (a portion of) the county highway known as Boundary Lane, in the First Road District, as hereinafter described, was regularly held on this date after notice duly given, all evidence given by persons interested has been heard and considered, and the Planning Commission has made its report on said proposal; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled this 17th day of March, 1958 that the (portion of the) said county highway hereinafter described is unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and all right therein is abandoned, reserving and excepting the easement and right of way therein for existing and future public utility, public service and drainage facilities and structures pursuant to Section 959.1 of the Streets and Highways Code, the abandoned portion of said highway being in the County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

All that portion of Boundary Lane, a 20-foot dedicated right of way lying between the northeasterly prolongation of the northwesterly line of Lot 16, Block 18, and the southeasterly prolongation of the southwesterly line of Lot 17, Block 18, as shown on Map of the Moulton and Praed Subdivision as filed in Book 3, Pages 13 and 14 of Maps, Records of Riverside County.
