WHEREAS, a proposal to abandon a portion of a county highway known as

~~BOOK 7, PAGE 66~~ Rindge Road in the 1st Road District, as

hereinafter described, was filed with the Board of Supervisors, and due and legal notice of a public hearing having been given as required by law, and the report of the Planning Commission having been made and filed, and all interested persons having been heard, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on March 21, 1960, that

a portion of ~~BOOK 7, PAGE 66~~ the county highway known as Rindge Road

and hereinafter described, is unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and all right therein is hereby abandoned, reserving and excepting the easement and right of way therein for existing and future public utility, public service and drainage facilities and structures pursuant to Section 959.1 of the Streets and Highways Code, said abandonment being in the County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

A portion of Lot NN and Lot F as shown on Map of Tract No. 2 of La Sierra Heights filed in Book 7, page 66 of Maps, records of Riverside County, more particularly described as follows:

PARCEL I - The southwesterly 7 feet of said Lot NN;

PARCEL II - The northeasterly 7 feet of said Lot NN;

PARCEL III - That portion of Lot F described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the southwesterly line of said Lot NN with the northwesterly line of said Lot F; Thence northeasterly along said northwesterly line of Lot F, a distance of 7.11 feet; Thence S. 15° 52' 45" E., a distance of 10.11 feet; Thence S. 65° 32' W., a distance of 7.11 feet; Thence N. 15° 52' 45" W., a distance of 10.11 feet to the point of beginning;

PARCEL IV - That portion of Lot F described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the northwesterly line of said Lot F with the northeasterly line of said Lot NN; Thence southwesterly along said northwesterly line of Lot F, a distance of 7.11 feet; Thence S. 15° 52' 45" E., a distance of 10.11 feet; Thence N. 65° 32' E., a distance of 7.11 feet; Thence N. 15° 52' 45" W., a distance of 10.11 feet to the point of beginning.

Reserving an easement therein for any existing public utilities. The purpose of this abandonment is to reduce the width of Rindge Road from 80 feet to 65 feet.

WHEREAS, a proposal to abandon ~~the right to accept the dedication of~~ a portion of a county highway known as Rindge Road in the 1st Road District, as hereinafter described, was filed with the Board of Supervisors, and due and legal notice of a public hearing having been given as required by law, and the report of the Planning Commission having been made and filed, and all interested persons having been heard, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on March 21 c., 1960, that ~~the right to accept the dedication of~~ a portion of the county highway known as Rindge Road and hereinafter described, is unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and all right therein is hereby abandoned, reserving and excepting the easement and right of way therein for existing and future public utility, public service and drainage facilities and structures pursuant to Section 959.1 of the Streets and Highways Code, said abandonment being in the County of Riverside, State of California and described as follows:

A portion of Lot III and Lot F as shown on Map of Tract No. 2 of La Sierra Heights filed in Book 7, page 66 of Maps, records of Riverside County, more particularly described as follows:

- PARCEL I - The southwesterly 7 feet of said Lot III;
- PARCEL II - The northeasterly 7 feet of said Lot III;
- PARCEL III - That portion of Lot F described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the southwesterly line of said Lot III with the northwesterly line of said Lot F; Thence northeasterly along said northwesterly line of Lot F, a distance of 7.11 feet; Thence S. 15° 52' 45" E., a distance of 7.11 feet; Thence S. 65° 32' W., a distance of 7.11 feet; Thence N. 15° 52' 45" W., a distance of 7.11 feet to the point of beginning;

PARCEL IV - That portion of Lot F described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the northwesterly line of said Lot F with the northeasterly line of said Lot III; Thence southwesterly along said northwesterly line of Lot F a distance of 7.11 feet; Thence S. 15° 52' 45" E., a distance of 7.11 feet; Thence N. 65° 32' E., a distance of 7.11 feet; Thence N. 15° 52' 45" W., a distance of 7.11 feet, to the point of beginning.

Reserving an easement therein for any existing public utilities. The purpose of this abandonment is to reduce the width of Rindge Road from 30 feet to 6 feet.
