AN EXTRACT FROM THE OFFICIAL RECORDS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA.

Moved by Trustee Chase, seconded by Trustee Lawler, that whereas, Elsie E. Bartlett, John Stewart, Riverside Trust Co., Ltd., by W. G. Fraser, Attorney in fact, and Jessie Stewart, abutting property owners, upon Lincoln Ave. between Meyers Street, known as Robert St. in Arlington Heights, and Harrison Street, in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and being the owners of all the property abutting upon said street, have filed a petition with the Clerk of this Board praying that said Lincoln Avenue between Meyers Street, known as Robert Street in Arlington Heights, and Harrison Street, be vacated by said city, and abandoned;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the petition of all the property holders abutting upon said street requesting the same,
Be it by this Board resolved, that Lincoln Ave. between Meyers Street, known as Robert Street in Arlington Heights, and Harrison Street, in said City of Riverside, be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned, and the same is hereby forever closed. Motion carried."
