RESOLUTION NO. 12012

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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 11996, AND MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING A PORTION OF MAIN STREET (DOWNTOWN MALL) BETWEEN NINTH AND TENTH STREETS.

WHEREAS on November 7, 1972, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 11996 declaring its intention to order the vacation of a portion of Main Street (Downtown Mall) between Ninth and Tenth Streets and fixing the time and place of hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Sections 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS said proposed vacation was submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by said Street Vacation Act of 1941; and

WHEREAS on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted that the portion of said street ordered vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the said portion of said street in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:

That portion of Main Street, 99.00 feet in width lying southwest of the southeast prolongation of the northeast line of Block 9, Range 7, and lying northeast of the southeast prolongation of the southwest line of said Block 9, Range 7 of the Town of Riverside, as shown by map on file in Book 7 of Maps, at page 17 thereof, records of San Bernardino County, California.

be and the same is hereby vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said


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City of Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested by the City Clerk under the seal of said City to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.

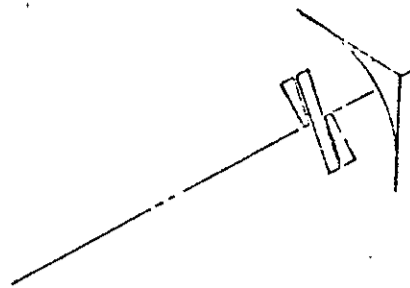
