It appearing to the Court and the Court now finds that heretofore on September 11, 1962, this Court made and gave its judgment in eminent domain in the above-entitled proceedings, which said judgment in eminent domain is hereby referred to and by reference incorporated herein and it further appearing to the Court that the plaintiff, City of Riverside, has made all payments that are required by law by the said judgment in eminent domain or by order of this Court and that full satisfaction of judgment has been filed herein,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that there is hereby condemned to the plaintiff, City of Riverside, as against the defendants and each of them all of the ^{properties} ~~land, property,~~ and property rights, including chattels and equipment, all as set forth in the plaintiff's complaint including title in fee simple absolute thereto where owned by the defendants and all

1 lesser interests and estates of said defendants therein,
 2 for the use, uses and purposes described and set forth in
 3 plaintiff's complaint, that is to say for the acquisition,
 4 construction, completion, operation and maintenance of a
 5 public utility and public improvement consisting of electric
 6 light, heat and power distribution and transmission lines in
 7 the City of Riverside and for all other purposes and uses
 8 authorized by the constitution and laws of the State of
 9 California and Charter of the City of Riverside, together with
 10 the right to enter upon all easements, rights of way and properties
 11 for the purpose of maintaining the said electrical transmission
 12 facilities.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that said
 14 uses are public uses and uses authorized by law.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that a copy
 16 of this order and judgment be filed in the office of the Recorder
 17 of the County of Riverside, State of California, and thereupon
 18 the property described in plaintiff's complaint and the title
 19 thereto shall vest in the plaintiff.
