RESOLVED, that, pursuant to the request set forth in a communication dated April 10, 1943, this day received and filed, a copy of which is attached to and made a part of this resolution and marked Exhibit "A", a temporary permit be, and the same is hereby, granted to Arthur S. Holden, No. 3755 Magnolia Avenue, Riverside, California, to construct and install, without cost to the City of Riverside, a private sewer line in Radcill Street in said City, to connect with the Van Buren Street sewer, with the understanding that the said sewer line will be constructed and installed under the supervision of, and to the satisfaction of the City Engineer and the Superintendent of Streets of said City, and with the further understanding that the said permit is revocable at any time at the will of the Council.
