



DIAGRAM exhibiting that portion of Twelfth Street in the City of Riverside on which work was done under my official contract as Street Superintendent of said City with the Shull Tucker Company under their contract dated July 22, 1916 for the construction of sidewalks, combination curb and gutters, roadway, catch basins drainage sewer, special curb and gutter, concrete alley entrances, etc. on a portion of Twelfth Street as is more particularly described in said contract to which reference is hereby made for further particulars. said diagram also showing the relative location of each lot, portion of lot, piece of parcel of land assessed for the work done, numbered in red ink to correspond to the red ink numbers in the assessment, the number of feet frontage, and the area in square feet of each of said lots, portions of lots, pieces or parcels of land assessed for the work done and performed.

Herein the location of the different kinds of work performed upon said portions of Twelfth Street is shown as follows:

- Macadam roadway constructed is shown thus:
 - Combination curb and gutter constructed is shown thus:
 - Cement sidewalk constructed is shown thus:
 - Type "E" catch basins constructed are shown thus:
 - Ten inch vitrified drainage sewers constructed are shown thus:
 - Alley entrances constructed of concrete are shown thus:
 - Special curb and gutter constructed at the intersection of Twelfth & Orange Streets is shown thus:
- Black figures in the center of lots show the numbers of said lots. Black figures next to the property lines show the length of said lines in feet. The mark "x" means feet. Black figures in each lot, portion of lot, piece or parcel of land, followed by the character "sq" show the area in square feet of each of said lots, portions of lots, pieces or parcels of land. The character "sq" means square feet. Property lines that differ from the recorded subdivisions are shown by broken lines except where the subdivision lines are entirely disregarded and the property is sold by metes and bounds; in those cases full black lines are used. Distances from property lines to quarter block lines are shown in parenthesis, when the distance does not embrace an entire lot, portion of lot, piece or parcel of land. The district benefited is bounded by a green line thus:

Property covered by this assessment is shown on the map of the Town, now City of Riverside as divided into blocks and ranges, and recorded in book 7 of maps, page 17, records of San Bernardino County California; on the map of Priestly Hall's subdivision of a portion of Block 11, Range 6 of the City of Riverside as recorded in book 1 of maps, page 1, records of Riverside County, California; and on the map of the Jarvis subdivision of Block 12, Range 6 of the City of Riverside as recorded in book 5 of maps, page 42, records of San Bernardino County, California.
