



Diagram exhibiting the District declared to be benefited by the construction of a public sewer in Walnut St in the City of Riverside as specified in Resolution of Intention No 65 and to be assessed to pay the cost and expenses thereof. Said sewer has been constructed under my official contract as Street Superintendent of said city with John Shiels & Sons dated the 20th day of August A.D. 1899 for the construction of a lateral sewer etc. in Walnut St as is more particularly described in said contract to which reference is hereby made. This diagram shows each separate lot piece or parcel of land the area in square feet of each of such lots pieces or parcels of land and the relative location of the same to the work done all within the limits of the assessment district numbered in red ink to correspond with the red ink numbers in the assessment. Herein the line of the sewer constructed is shown thus  $\text{---}$  and the combination manhole and flush tank is shown thus  $\square$ . The mark  $\text{---}$  means feet; the mark  $\square$  means square feet. Figures in black next to a property line show each the length of said line in feet. Figures in black followed by the character  $\square$  show each the area in square feet of each lot piece or parcel of land. The block and range descriptions of the blocks refer to the block and range descriptions shown on the Goldsworthy and Higbie Map of the Town of Riverside a copy of which is of record in the office of the County Recorder of the County of San Bernardino State of California. The exterior boundary of the district to be assessed is shown thus  $\text{---}$ .
