

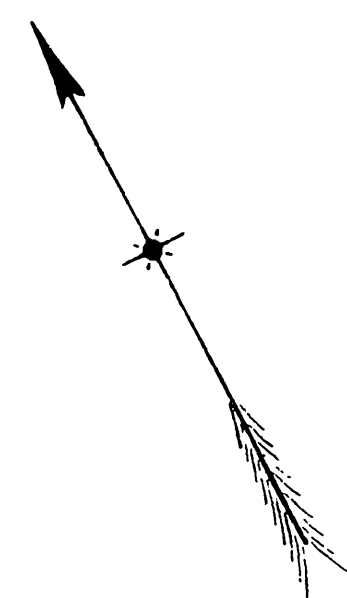
# MAP OF OAKLEY'S SUBDIVISION

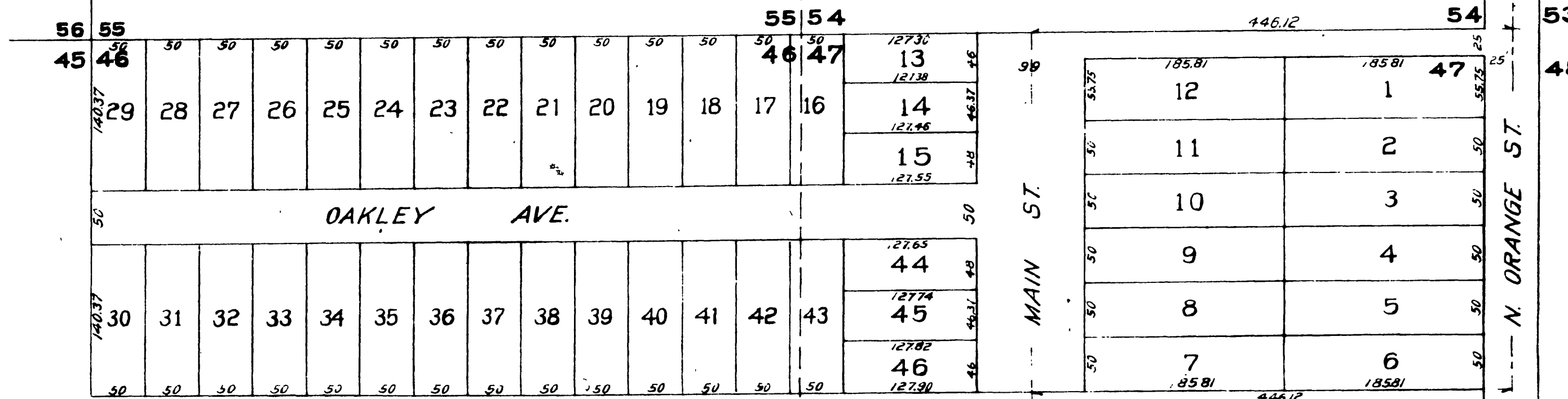
