 Emerald St. and Evans St., and also checked by computed closure
 of the boundary of said lot 4.

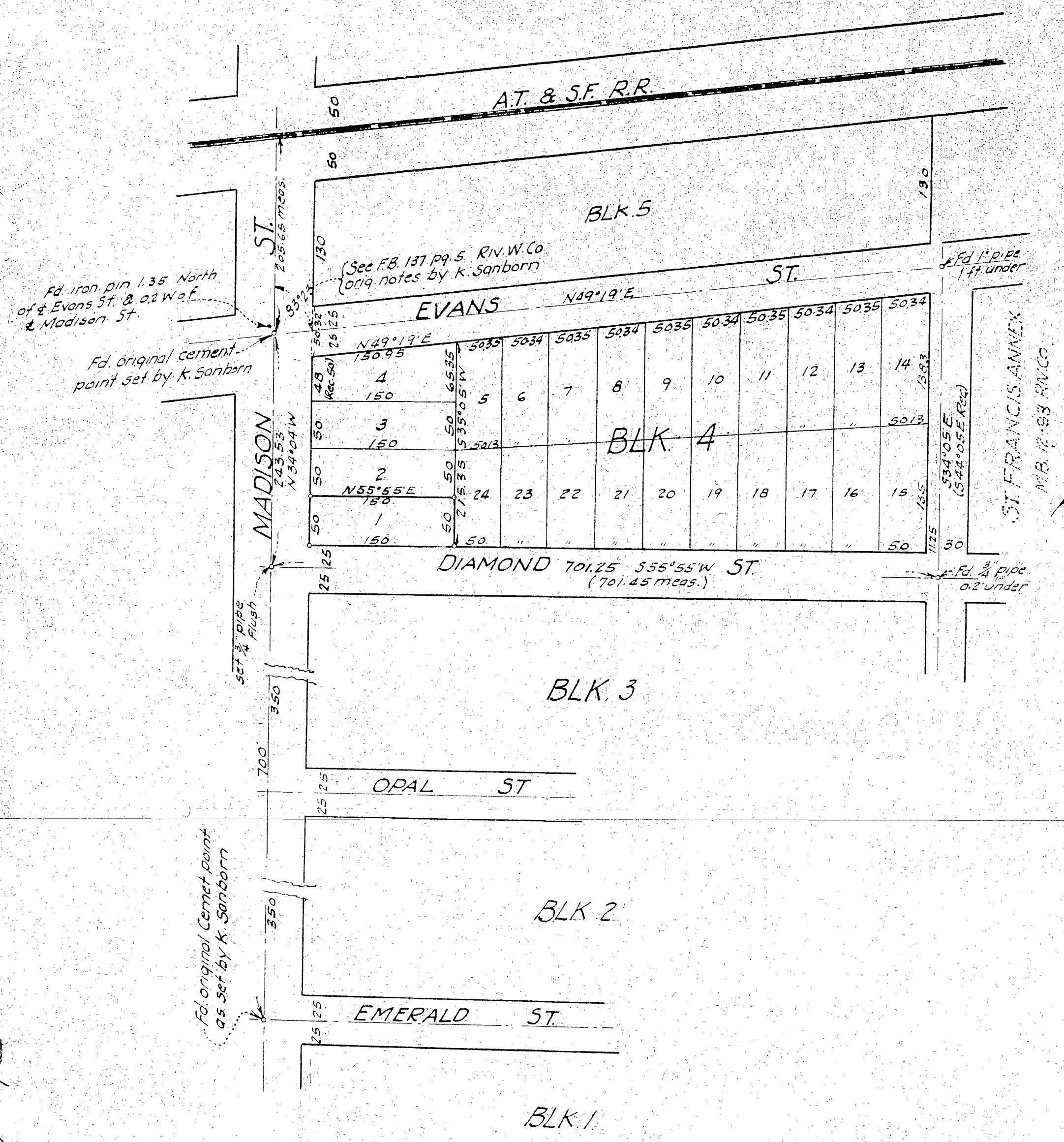
