



GENERAL NOTES

1. Construction shall be in accordance with the Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction 1973 Edition, and the City of Riverside Standard Drawings.
2. It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to clear the Right of Way in accordance with the provisions of law as it affects each utility including irrigation lines and appurtenances and at no cost to the City.
3. Pipe shall be bedded per Case I, standard Drawing No. 452, unless otherwise specified on the plans.
4. Location of wyes and laterals to be determined in the field at the direction of the owner.
5. All stubs and laterals to be determined in the field at the direction of the owner.
6. Manhole frames and covers to be set as noted in profiles by sewer contractor after final paving of streets.
7. Laterals are to be 4" V.C.P. and extended to property line.
8. Prior to construction of sewer Contractor is to expose the existing sewer and contact the Engineer for verification of existing location and elevation. (See "Special Note" hereon).
9. Plug shall be installed and will remain in place where the new sewer connects with the existing sewer until the new sewer is accepted by the City.

SPECIAL NOTE:

Contractor shall expose existing sewer outlets from all buildings prior to construction of 8" sewer main so that the private Engineer can determine if the main must be lowered or may be raised.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTOR

The existence and location of underground utility pipes or structures shown on these plans are obtained by a search of the available records, to the best of our knowledge there are no existing utilities except as shown on these plans. The contractor is required to take due precautionary measures to protect the utility lines shown and any other lines not of record or not shown on these plans. SEE "SPECIAL NOTE" HEREON.
