



- GENERAL NOTES:**
- BENCH MARK: PL Nail in lead in NW curb return (not the point) City File Book No. 980-50 thru 980-52
 - All work shall be done in accordance with these plans, standard specifications No. 401 and the standard drawings of the City of Riverside Department of Public Works.
 - It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to clear the right of way in accordance with the provisions of the law as it applies to this project including possession lines and encroachments and at no cost to the City.
 - Prime coat, paint binder, and seal coat are required.
 - Grading will require a permit under ordinance No. 3582.
 - It shall be the contractor's responsibility to fill over 1' in depth of existing paving where new paving joins existing pavement in a given straight line. Construct mold in paving as shown and overlap paving as indicated in the plan to produce a smooth cross section. Existing curbs extend to 6' 0" max.
 - Overlays to be constructed per Riverside City Ord. No. 322 and located in the street shown on these plans. The contractor shall be responsible for any damage to underground facilities.
 - The subgrade shall be prepared for a soil test to be done by a soil engineer after the street has been prepared to rough grade. Report of soil test shall be submitted to the City of Riverside.
